2. Description of the Indicator Light

1. Blue: the socket is off.

2. White: the socket is on.

3. Green: the socket is on
and loaded.

reaches 80% of full load,
reminding not to operate in this
state for too long.

3. Network Connection

WiFi

1. Scan the QR code to download the

“Smart Life” app.

2. Press and hold the button for more than 3 seconds until the LED starts flashing quickly, indicating that the device is ready for configuration.
3. Ensure that the mobile phone is connected to the 2.4 GHz Wi-Fi network and has Bluetooth enabled, then open the “Smart Life” app. Click “+” (Add Sub-device) to select the device and follow the on-screen instructions to pair the devices.

Zigbee

1. Scan the QR code to download the “Smart Life” app.
2. Ensure that the Zigbee gateway is connected to the app.
3. Press and hold the button for more than 3 seconds until the LED starts flashing quickly, indicating that the device is ready for configuration.
4. Enter the gateway connection interface, select the Zigbee device, click “+” (Add Sub-device) and follow the on-screen instructions to pair the devices.

4. Precautions

- Do not disassemble the smart socket yourself – contact technical support for repairs.
- Keep away from liquids to prevent short circuits.
- Use only a dry cloth – avoid

cleaning with liquids/detergents.

- Do not place near open flames or heat sources.
- Disconnect from power during a storm.
- Ensure proper ventilation and avoid stacking sockets.

Usage Warnings
