Product Function Introduction

Function ①: Upgrade the original wired CarPlay to wireless CarPlay or wireless Android Auto, plug-and-play, automatic connection, so that the phone is free from the data cable constraints, enjoy the convenience of wireless transmission.

Function ②: Upgrade the original Carplay to HDMI adapter, easily and quickly convert HDMI high-definition resources to the original car screen, to meet your pursuit of excellent and interesting entertainment driving experience.

Reset

Long press the side button to reset the product, after resetting, you need to reconnect the wireless CarPlay/Android Auto.

CarPlay: iPhone 6 or above, iOS 10+

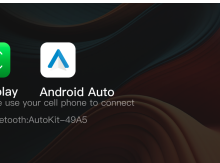
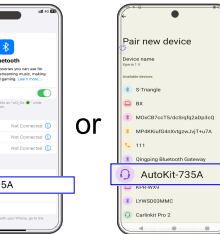

Connect the product to the car's data interface through the data cable, wait until the product is powered on and the CarPlay icon is on, then click the CarPlay icon to enter the product connection interface.

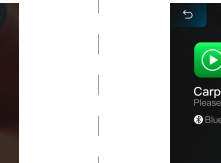
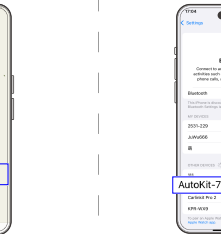
Wireless CarPlay Connection Steps

1. Turn on WiFi and Bluetooth on your iPhone.
2. In the iPhone Bluetooth list interface, connect the product Bluetooth name "AutoKit-****".
3. After the iPhone passes the CarPlay related prompts, you can enter the wireless CarPlay.



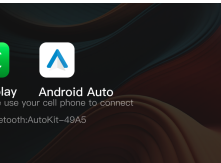
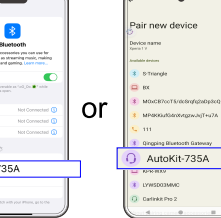
Wireless Android Auto Connection Steps

1. Turn on your mobile phone's WiFi and Bluetooth.
2. In the mobile phone Bluetooth list interface, connect the product Bluetooth name "AutoKit-****".
3. After your mobile phone passes the Android Auto related prompts, you can enter the wireless Android Auto.



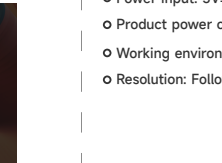
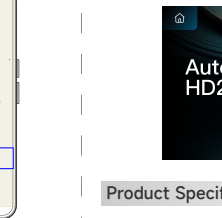
HDMI IN

1. Click the monitor icon on the product connection interface.
2. Connect the external device that supports HDMI output (such as TV box, game box, game console, video player, laptop, etc.) to the HDMI port of the product via HDMI cable to enjoy high-definition entertainment resources.



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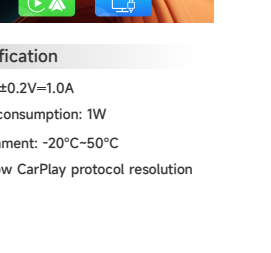
Online update version/problem feedback method

iPhone:

Method 1, when CarPlay is connected, use Safari to visit the URL 192.168.1.101 directly.

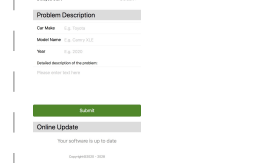
Method 2, when CarPlay is not connected, use iPhone to connect to the product's WiFi (WiFi name: AutoKit-****, password 88888888), and visit the URL 192.168.1.101 only after successful connection.



Android Phones:

Android phone can't visit the URL 192.168.1.101 directly when Android Auto connects, you need to do the following settings.

- 1, turn off Bluetooth and WiFi in the phone settings and then turn on WiFi
- 2, connect the product WiFi (WiFi name AutoKit - ****, password 88888888)
- 3, after the WiFi is connected, visit the URL 192.168.1.101 in the browser.

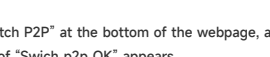

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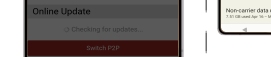
