Safety Precautions

Before starting to charge, check that the device contacts are clean. Never leave the device unattended while in use and charging. Ensure that you can quickly disconnect the device from the power source in an emergency. Never expose the device to high temperatures. Charge the device in a dry and well-ventilated place away from flammable materials, maintaining a minimum distance of 1m from other objects. Never cover the device while charging. Never use a power supply, charging station, cables, etc., without the manufacturer's recommendation and certification. To maintain the maximum lifespan of the battery, it is not recommended to discharge it below 3.18V or 15% of the total capacity. Lower values, such as 2.5V for the cell, permanently damage it and this is not covered by the warranty. If the battery or the entire device is not used for more than one month, the battery should be charged to 50% and its charge level should be checked periodically every two months. Store the battery and device in a dry place, away from sunlight and negative temperatures.

LI-PO Battery

The device is equipped with a LI PO (lithium-polymer) battery, which ages over time and use due to its physical and chemical structure. The manufacturer specifies the maximum operating time of the device under laboratory conditions, where optimal working conditions for the device exist, and the battery itself is new and fully charged. Actual operating time may differ from that declared in the offer and this is not a defect of the device but a feature of the product. To maintain the maximum lifespan of the battery, it is not recommended to discharge it below 3.5V or 5% of the total capacity. Lower values, such as 3.2V for the cell, permanently damage it and this is not covered by the warranty.

In the case of discontinuing the use of the battery or the entire device for more than one month, the battery should be charged to 50% and the charge level should be checked periodically every two months. Store the battery and device in a dry place, away from sunlight and negative temperatures. Warnings and safety information

All information regarding operation and usage can be found in the user manual or on the product label. Before starting to use the product, familiarize yourself with its content and follow the instructions contained therein. Also, review the following information before use:

User safety

1. Use the screwdriver for its intended purpose – Screwdrivers are designed for driving and removing screws. Using them for other tasks may lead to tool damage or injury. 2. Check the condition of the tool – Before use, ensure that the screwdriver is in good condition. Check that the handle is not cracked and the screwdriver tip is not worn or damaged.
