## INTRODUCTION

1 Microphone

High-sensitivity capsule

(male 3-pin XLR connector)

on/off switch

Audio cable – 4.5 m (14.8 ft)

XLR to 1/4" Mic C

female 3-pin XLR connector

## PREPARATION

Dynamic microphones are sturdy, moisture-resistant, and can achieve high gain before feedback. They do not require phantom power, so you only need the microphone and cable!

1. Connect the supplied 3-pin XLR cable with the angled plug to the microphone base.

### NOTE:

Press and hold the button to disconnect the cable from the microphone. Press and hold

2. Lower the speaker volume to avoid feedback.

3. Connect the microphone to the speaker equipped with a 1/4" microphone input jack.

4. Turn on the microphone (pressing up turns it on, pressing down turns it off).

5. Slowly increase the speaker volume for better effect.

6. Keep your mouth close to the dynamic microphone for a louder effect.

7. Windshields protect the microphone from dirt and help extend its lifespan, reducing wind noise, breath sounds, and popping. Use a windscreen for the microphone if necessary.
