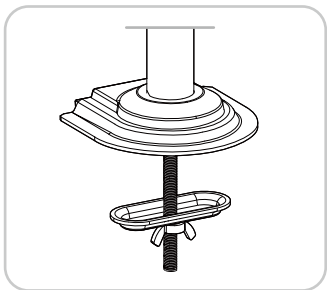
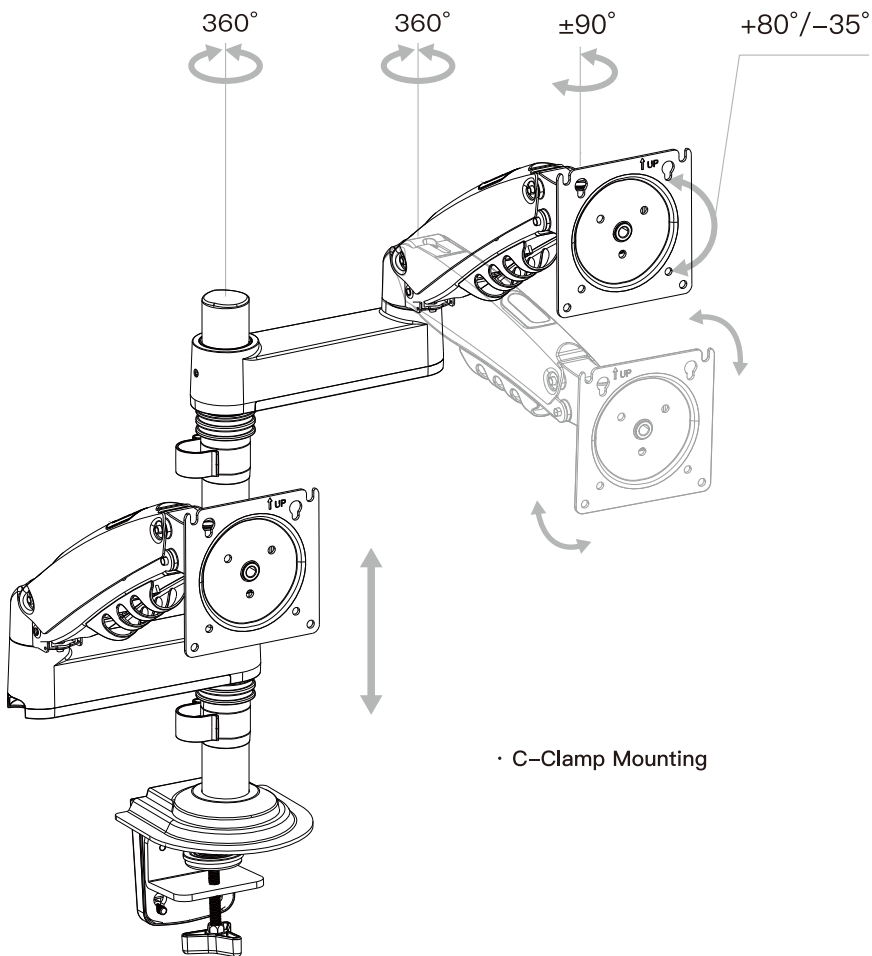


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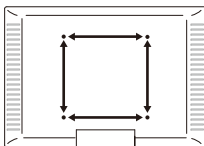
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Product Features



Before getting started, let's make sure this mount is compatible.

- 1** Is the VESA pattern of your monitor 75 x 75mm (3 x 3") or 100 x 100mm (3.9 x 3.9")?

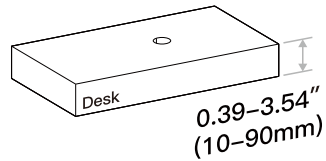
Step 1 Install the Base

For C-Clamp Mounting,
follow Option A on this page.

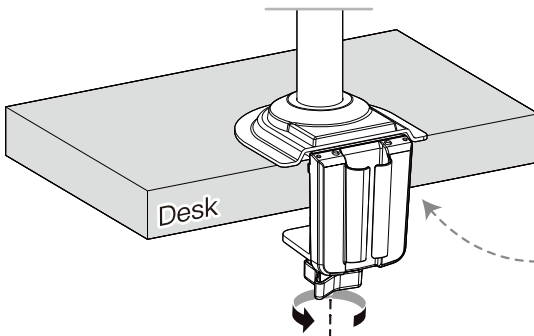
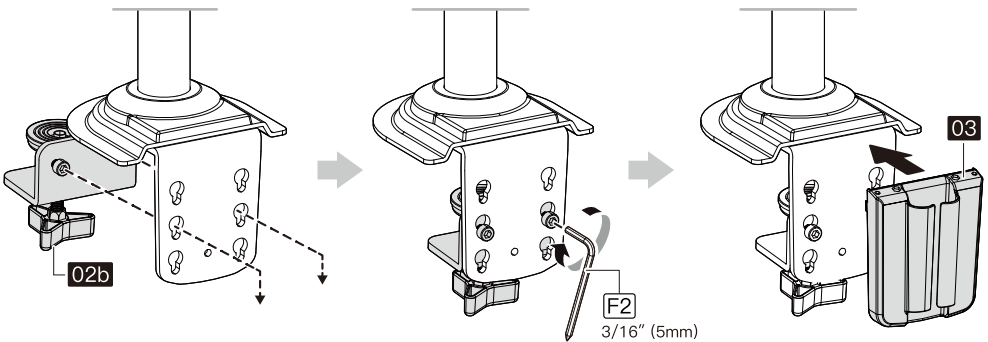
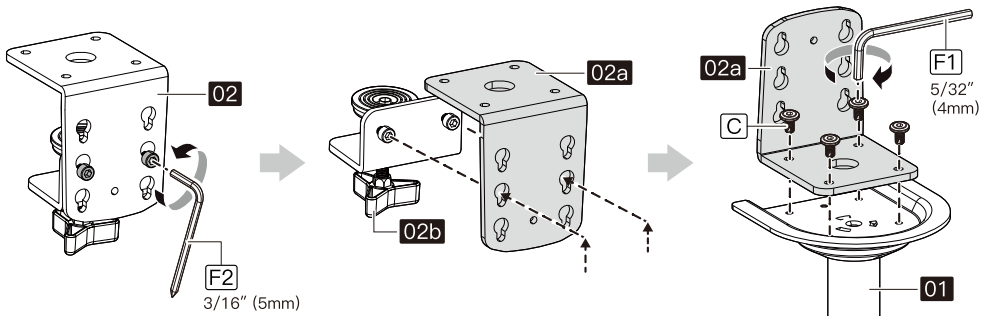

Option A: For C-Clamp Mounting



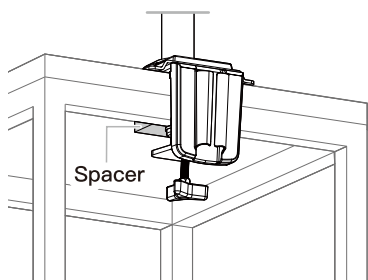
Note: The C-clamp should contact the desk and the locking knob should be secured vertically against the bottom of the desk.



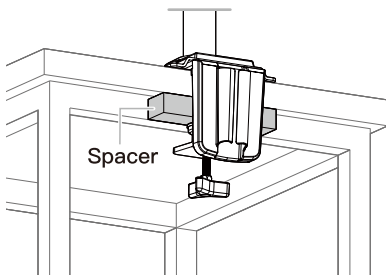
If your desktop does not fit properly, you may be able to use a wood board or block as a spacer. Please note that the oval C-clamp plate must make full contact with the desk and/or wood spacer.

Example 1

If there is a crossbar underneath the desk, you need to use a spacer that is the same height as the crossbar.

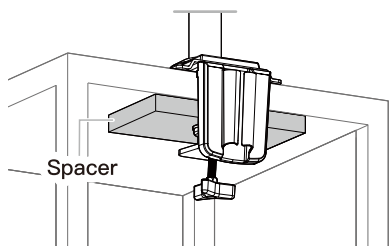

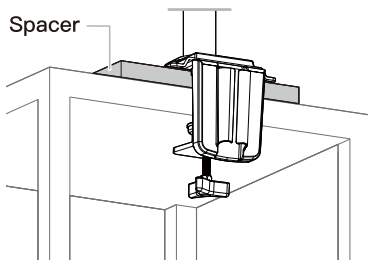
Example 2

A spacer can be placed underneath the desk to fulfill the required dimensions.



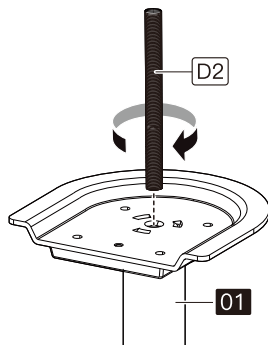
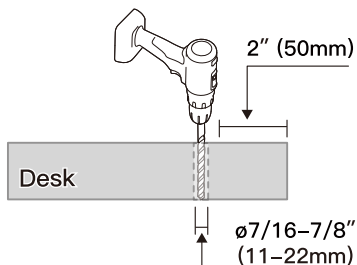
Example 3

A spacer can also be placed on top of the desk to maximize installation height.

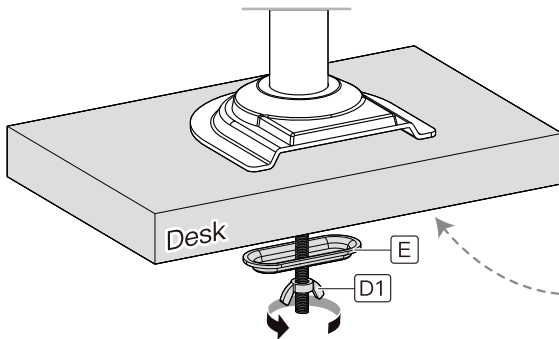


Option B: For Grommet Mounting

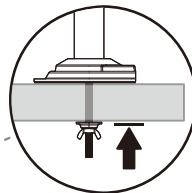
Note: If there is no grommet hole on your desktop, mark a hole in the desired position. Be sure to leave 2" (50mm) from the edge of the desktop. Drill a hole using a drill bit in the diameter of 7/16-7/8" (11-22mm).



Note: Ensure the grommet bolt is screwed securely.

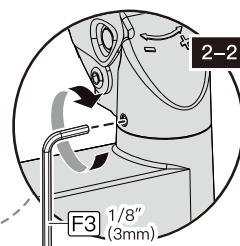
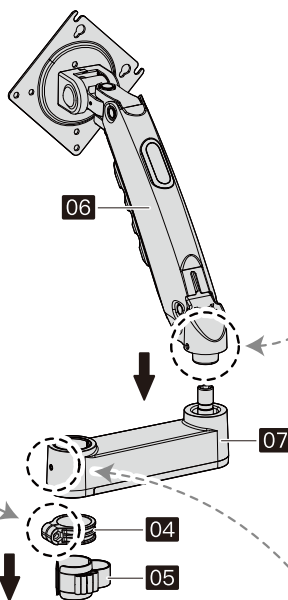
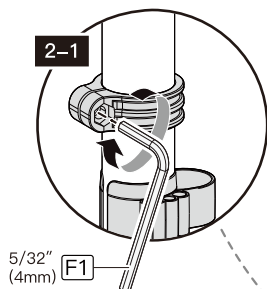


Note: Fully tighten to secure the locking plate to the bottom of the desk.

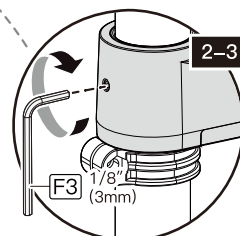
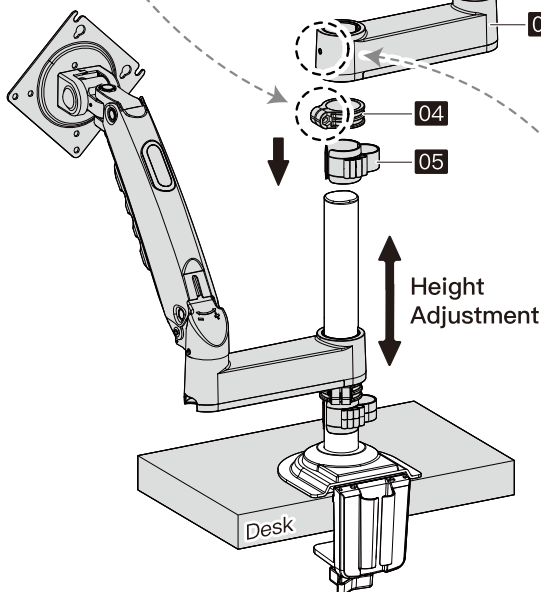


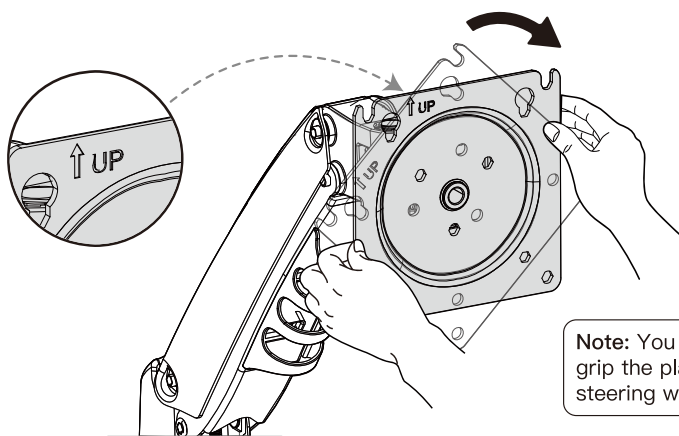
Step 2 Install the Arms

Note: Fully tighten the bolt.



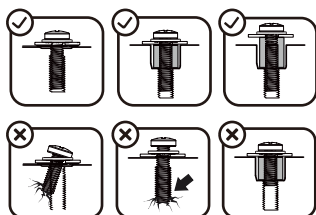
Note: Do not overtighten, as this may affect the rotation of the arms.



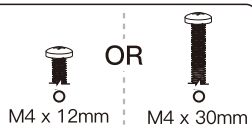


Note: You may need to grip the plate like a steering wheel to rotate.

Step 3 Hang the Monitors on the Mount

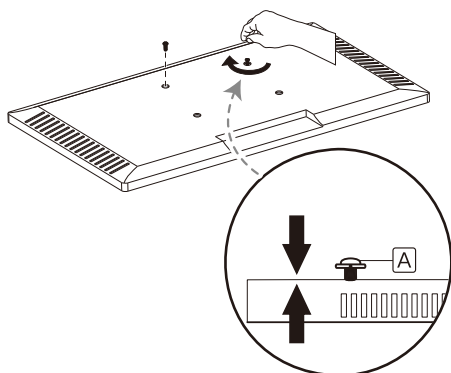


Only one bolt size fits the monitor.

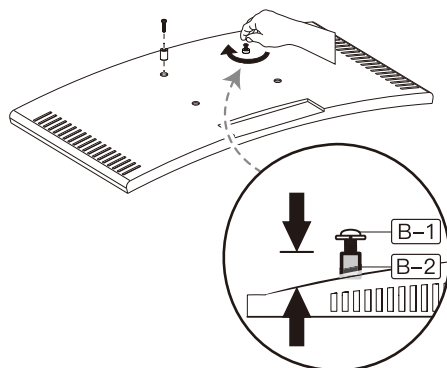


Choose the bolt and spacer configuration that fits your monitor type. Thread in the top bolts, but do not tighten all the way yet.

For Flat Back Monitor

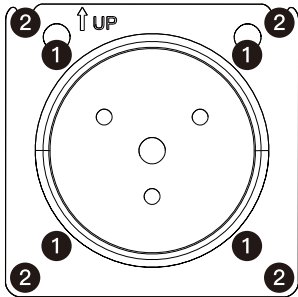


For Curved Back Monitor



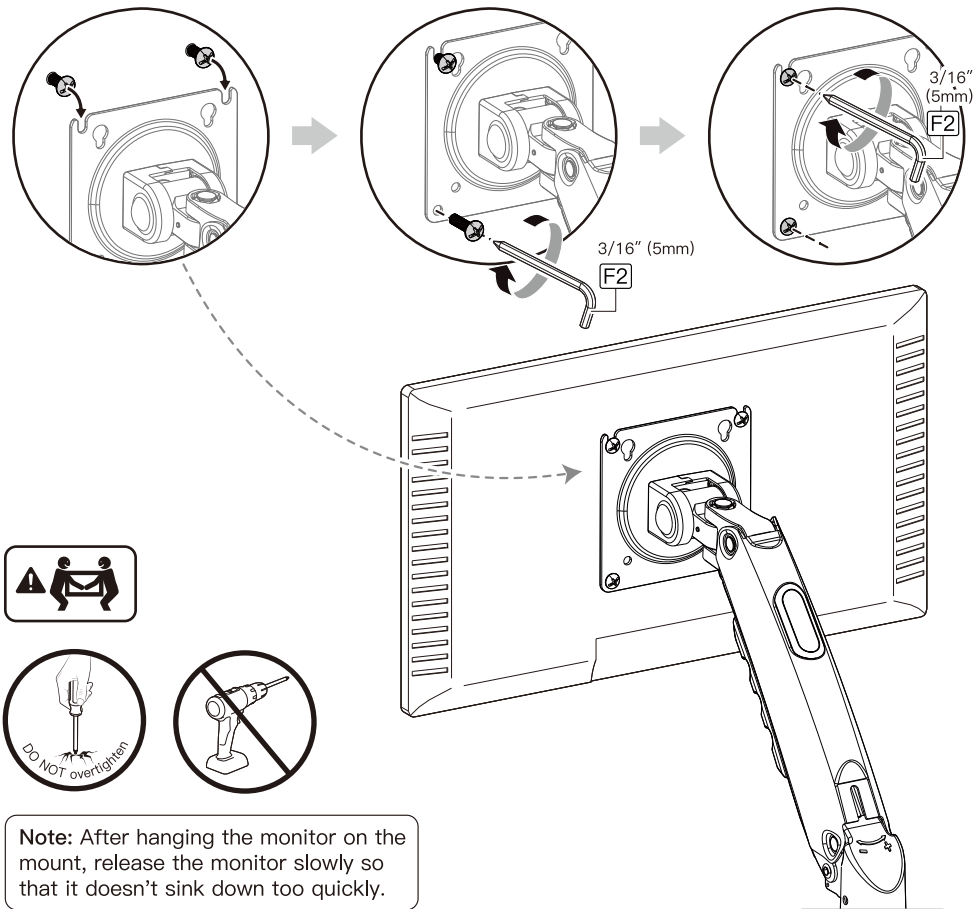
OR

With the top bolts attached, hang the monitor onto the VESA plate using the top 100mm slots or 75mm holes. Thread in the bottom bolts, then firmly tighten all bolts to secure the monitor to the mount arm.



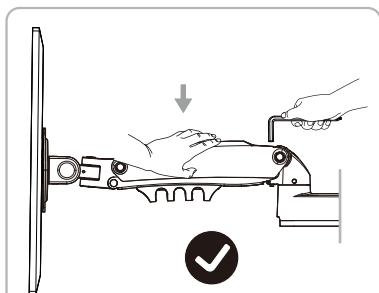
For VESA hole pattern:

- 1 75 x 75mm (3 x 3")
- 2 100 x 100mm (3.9 x 3.9")



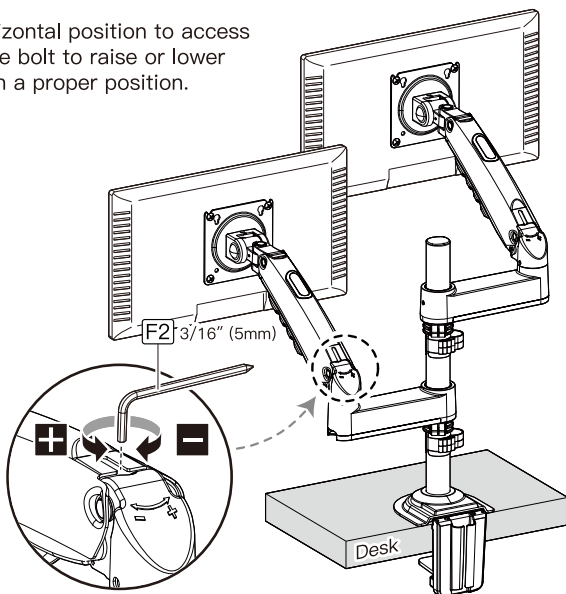
Step 4 Adjust Monitor Height

- 1 Press the upper arm down into a horizontal position to access the gas spring tension bolt. Adjust the bolt to raise or lower the upper arm so the monitor stays in a proper position.



⚠ CAUTION:

To avoid damage to monitor or mount, always keep the arm in a horizontal position while making adjustments. You may need assistance with this step.

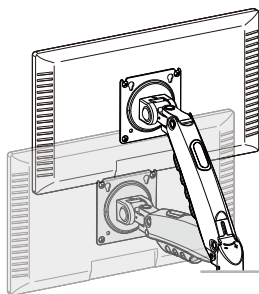


- 2 Use the large Allen key to adjust the height of the upper arm until the monitor stays in position.

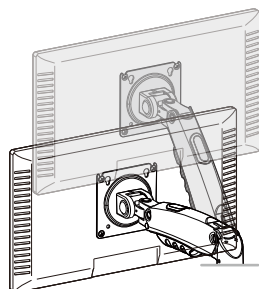


If Arm
Falls Down



If the upper arm falls and you cannot raise it, turn counterclockwise ("+" direction) until the monitor can stay at the desired height by itself.

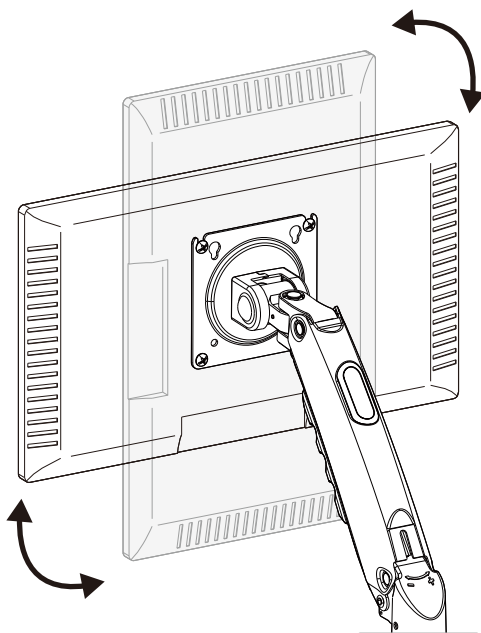
If Arm
Rises Up



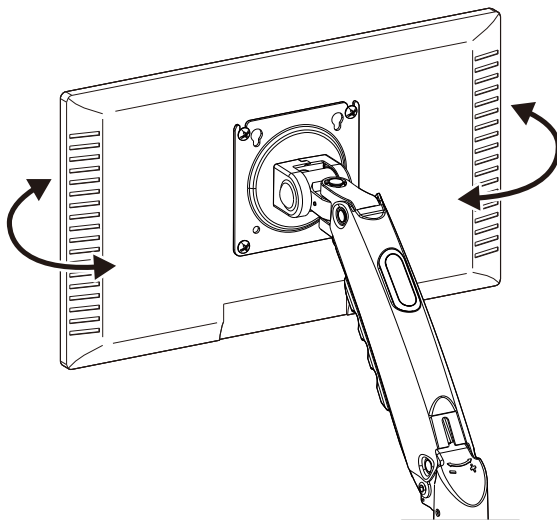
If the upper arm rises and you cannot lower it, turn clockwise ("-\" data-bbox="567 855 892 922"/>

5-1 Monitor Rotation

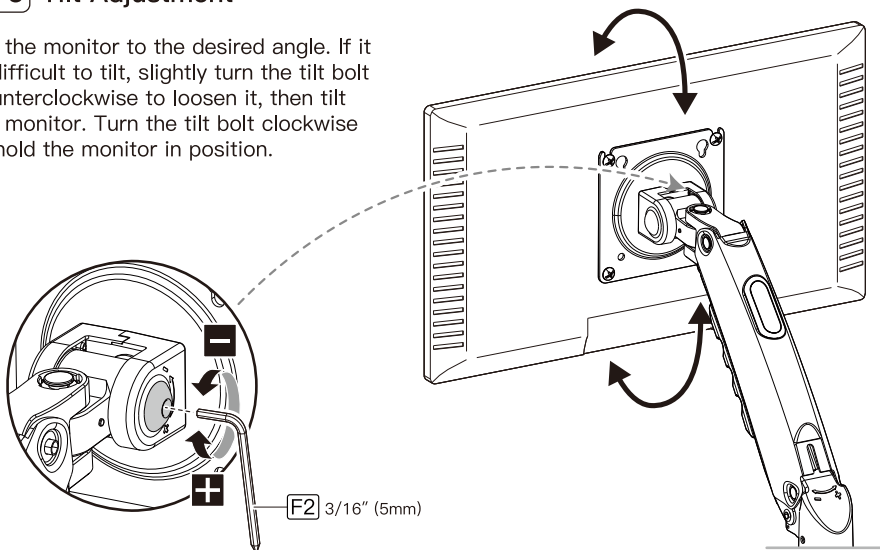


5-2 Swivel Adjustment

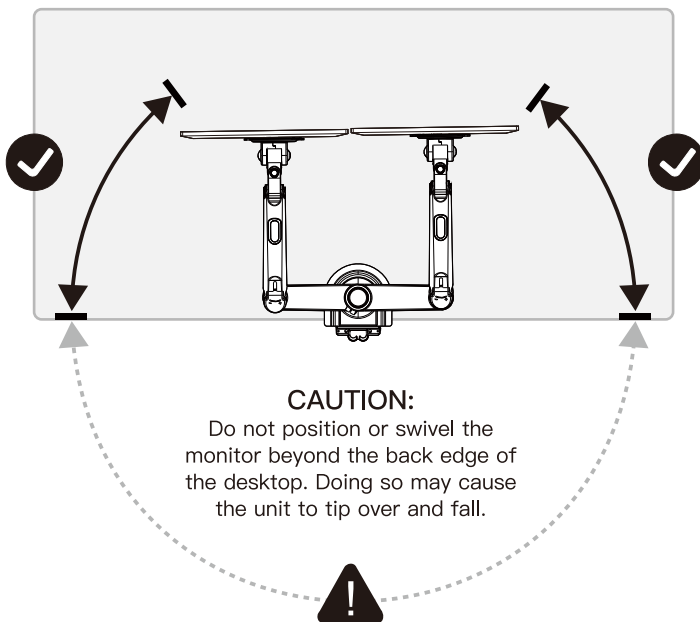


5-3 Tilt Adjustment

Tilt the monitor to the desired angle. If it is difficult to tilt, slightly turn the tilt bolt counterclockwise to loosen it, then tilt the monitor. Turn the tilt bolt clockwise to hold the monitor in position.

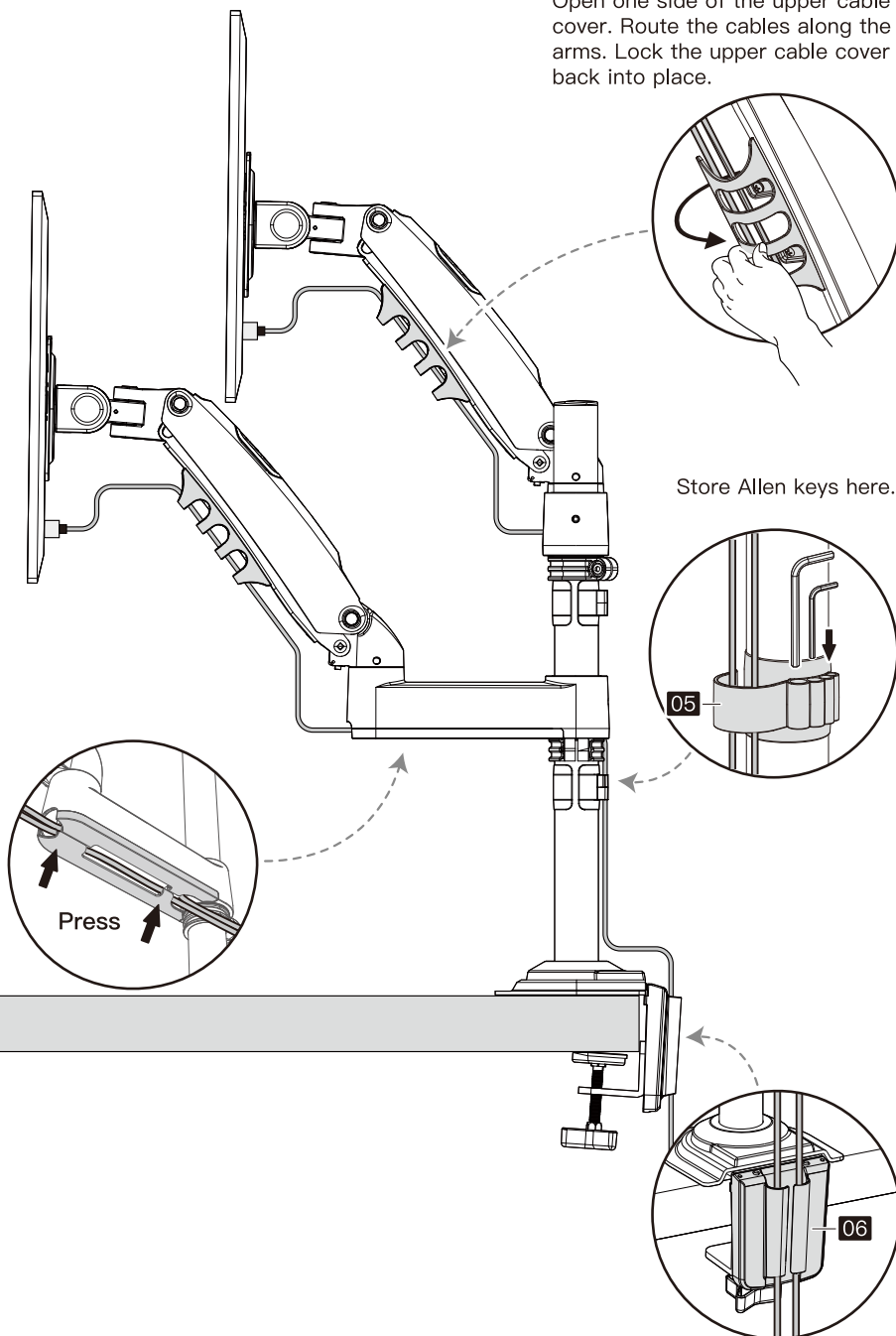


Step 6 Swivel Restriction



Step 7 Cable Management

Open one side of the upper cable cover. Route the cables along the arms. Lock the upper cable cover back into place.



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
