# How to use

## Connect Bluetooth using device

1. When the headset has power, press the power button for 3 seconds and there will be a power-on beep. Then the power indicator light will flash (blue light flashes in Bluetooth mode/white light flashes in 2.4G mode). At this time, the headset enters the search and pairing state.
2. At this time, please find the Bluetooth name of the headset "B2" in the device Bluetooth list, click Connect, and the headset will sound a prompt after the connection is successful.
3. The headset can remember previously paired devices. When making a secondary connection, you only need to turn on Bluetooth in the device. At the same time, the headset enters the power-on state, and it will automatically connect back to the device (if there is no reconnection, please find it in the Bluetooth list Click the Bluetooth name to connect).
4. The mode in which the headset is turned on is based on the mode in which it was last turned off.
5. If the headset is in the Bluetooth connection state, double-clicking the power button will disconnect the connected device and enter the Bluetooth search state.

Press and hold the microphone button for 3 seconds  
(2.4G/BT dual-mode switching)

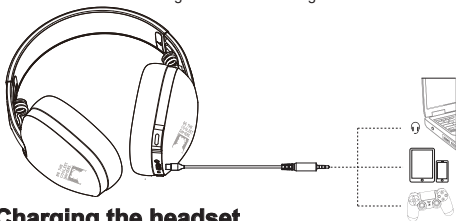


BT: Enter Bluetooth search pairing mode, the blue light flashes, and the blue light stays on when pairing is successful.

2.4G: Enter 2.4G search pairing mode, the white light flashes, and the white light stays on when pairing is successful.

## Line mode (optional)

The earphones and devices can work directly by inserting a Line cable. If the earphones are in Bluetooth mode, the earphones will automatically shut down and enter Line cable working mode after inserting the Line cable

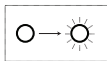


## Charging the headset

The headphones are partially charged at the factory, please make sure they are fully charged before first use.

1. The headset has a built-in battery. If it is not used for a long time, it should be charged at least once every three months.
2. The package is equipped with a Type-c charging cable, which can be charged when plugged in (adaptive charger 5V/1A)
3. The red light of the earphones is always on when charging, and turns off when fully charged.
