



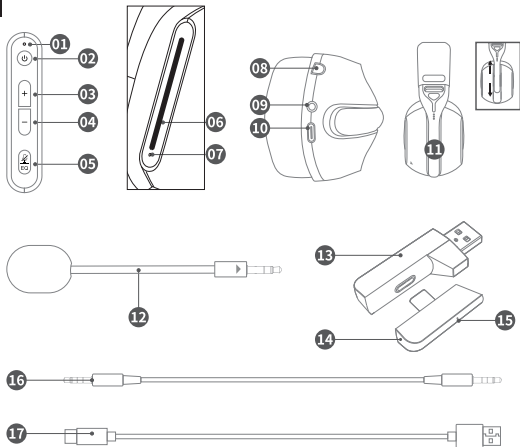

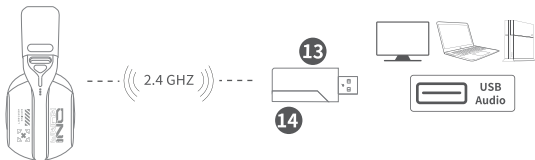

Functional Controls

Power on	Long press the power button for 5 seconds
Shutdown	Press and hold the power button for 5 seconds
RGB light on/off	Press the power button twice quickly
Volume+	Short press "+"
Volume-	Short press "-"
Previous song	Long press the+key for 2 seconds
Next song	Long press the - key for 2 seconds
Play/Pause	Short press the power button
Answer/hang up calls	Short press the power button
Refuse to answer	Press the power button for 2 seconds during incoming calls
Microphone on/off	Short press the EQ key
2.4G/ wireless switching	Double click the EQ key twice
EQ On/Off	Long press the EQ key for 2 seconds

Compatible with PC/MAC/Playstation 4/5/ Connected via USB-A



Precautions for transmitter pairing

1. It is paired before leaving the factory and can be used synchronously with the headphones by plugging it in (double-click the "EQ" button twice to switch to Gaming mode)
2. When using, plug in the USB port of the computer, the green indicator light of the transmitter flashes, and the device displays "GT808" on the computer, indicating that the wireless headphone device has been successfully installed.
3. When using this device for the first time, open the "Select Sound Output" option in the "Open Sound Settings" and set "GT808" as the default.
4. Re pairing: Press and hold the " + - " key for 2 seconds at the same time.
