Usage Instructions and Manual

1. The headset can be used with four-pole 3.5 mm audio devices with a single connector, such as laptops, tablets, mobile phones, etc. A dual 3.5 mm computer connector can be used with a two-part 3.5 mm adapter cable.
2. Generally, the end of the cable or microphone is designed for the left side, so when using

the headset, the end of the cable or microphone should be worn near the left ear.

3. When using the headset on a computer, ensure that the headset microphone switch is turned on; then make sure that the computer microphone switch is also turned on.

4. Find the "Speaker" icon on the computer's main panel and tap it to access the volume control settings and enter the "Voice" settings in the "Control Panel".

4. Ensure that the headset volume control is set to the minimum volume and can be adjusted to the appropriate volume.

5. Use the headset and enjoy gaming.
