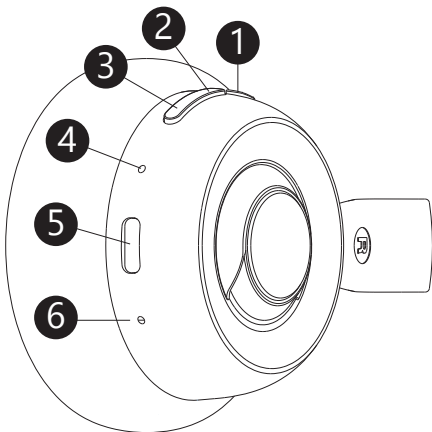

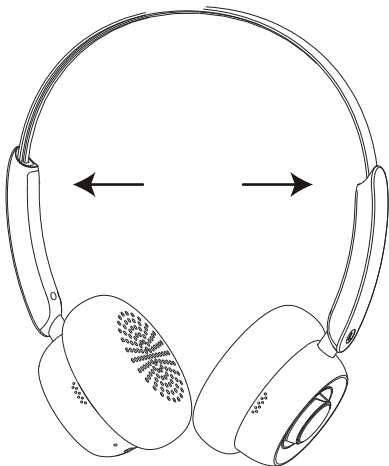

1. Rotate the headset and find a suitable position.
2. Extend the headset arms and find the right height.
3. Make sure ear pads provide a tight seal around the ears
4. Make sure the headrest fits closely with the top of the head.

We recommend not pulling the headphone cups as far apart as possible, gently pull them so that they fit on your head, then adjust the height.

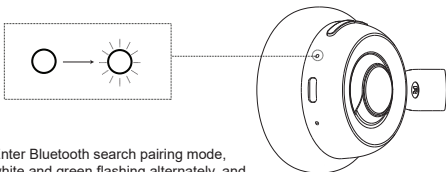
Function Control

Power On	Hold power button for 2 seconds
Power Off	Hold power button for 3 seconds any time
Volume +	Short press "+"
Volume -	Short press "-"
Previous Track	Long press the "-" key
Next Track	Long press the "+" key
Play/Pause	Short press the power button
Answer/Hang up	Short press the power button
Refuse to answer	Press and hold the power button for 2 seconds during the incoming call
Clear pairing information	Bluetooth: When turned on, press and hold the "+" and "-" keys for 5 seconds (after clearing the pairing information between the earphones and Bluetooth devices) to enter the pairing unconnected state
Game Mode	Double click on the 'power button'
Activate voice assistant	Three clicks on the 'power button'

How to use

Connect the device to Bluetooth

1. Pressing the power button for 3 seconds while the earphones are charged will emit a "power on" sound, followed by the power indicator light flashing alternately in white and green. At this point, the earphones enter Bluetooth search pairing mode.
2. At this point, please find the Bluetooth name "GT820" for the earphones in the device Bluetooth list, click connect, and after successful connection, the earphones will prompt with a "connected" sound.
3. The earphones can remember the previously paired devices, and when making a secondary connection, simply turn on the Bluetooth in the device. At the same time, the earphones will enter the power on state, and it will automatically reconnect with the device (if there is no reconnection, please find the Bluetooth name in the Bluetooth list and click to connect).
4. If you want to change the paired device while it is connected, you can force the earphones to enter pairing mode (Bluetooth: power on state, press and hold the "+" and "-" keys for 5 seconds (after clearing the pairing information between the earphones and Bluetooth devices) to enter pairing unconnected state).

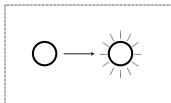


Enter Bluetooth search pairing mode, white and green flashing alternately, and the pairing success indicator light goes out.

Charging the headset

The headphones have been partially charged at the factory. Please ensure that they are fully charged before using them for the first time.

1. The earphones are equipped with a built-in battery. If not used for a long time, they should be charged at least once every three months. The flashing white light indicates a low battery state.
2. The package is equipped with a Type-C charging cable, which can be charged by plugging in the power supply (Suitable for 5V charger).
3. The white light of the earphone charging is always on, and it turns off when fully charged.
