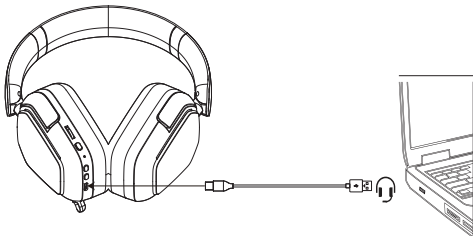

Line mode (optional)

Inserting the Type-C cable with audio into Line mode allows direct operation. If the earphones are in wireless mode, inserting the Type-C cable with audio will automatically shut down the earphones and enter Line mode.

Function Control

Power on	Hold power button for 3 seconds
Power off	Hold power button for 5 seconds any time
Volume +	Scroll wheel up
Volume -	Scroll wheel down
Previous Track	Double tap the power button
Next Track	Triple tap the power button
Play/Pause	Press power button
Answer/Hang up	Press power button
Refuse to answer	Hold power button for 2 seconds
Clear pairing information	wireless: When turned on, press the power button five times to clear pairing information and then turn off the device 2.4G: With the device powered on, press and hold the power button for 10 seconds. After the device is powered on, let the green light flash quickly. Insert the dongle to re-pair.
Dongle/Wireless Mode	Double-click the microphone button (Wireless - solid blue light; 2.4G - solid green light).
light on/off	Long press the light button 2S
MIC on/off	Single-click the microphone button
Activate voice assistant	When the headset is in operation, double-click the light button

How to use

Connect the device wirelessly

1. Pressing the power button for 3 seconds while the earphones are charged will emit a "power on" sound, followed by a flashing blue light on the power indicator. At this point, the earphones enter wireless search pairing mode.
2. At this point, please find the wireless name of the earphone "GT883" in the device wireless list, click on the connection, and after successful connection, the earphone will prompt with a "connected" sound
3. The earphones can remember the previously paired devices, and only need to turn on the wireless connection in the device when making a secondary connection. At the same time, the earphones will enter the power on state, and it will automatically reconnect with the device (if there is no reconnection, please find the wireless name in the wireless list and click to connect).

If you want to change the paired device while it is already connected, you can force the earphones to enter pairing mode

(When the headset is powered on (connected or not), press the power button five times to clear pairing information, then power off, then insert a dongle to re-pair.)

2.4G: When the headset is powered on, press the power button five times to clear pairing information, then power off, then insert a dongle to re-pair.

The blue light flashes when the headset enters search and pairing mode. If pairing is successful, the blue light will remain on. When the headset enters search and pairing mode, the green light flashes. If pairing is successful, the green light remains on.
