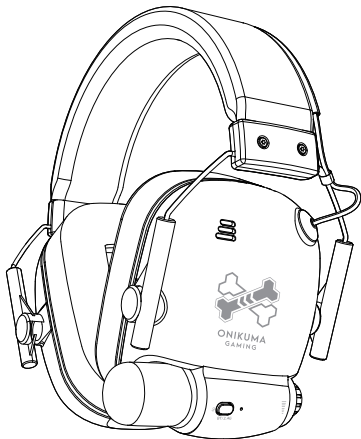

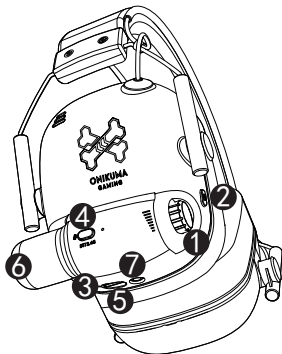
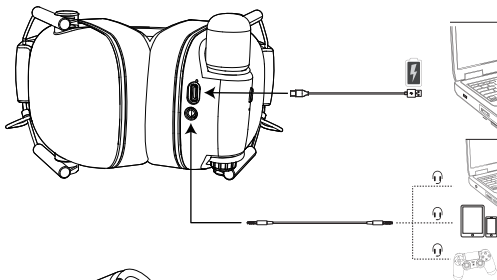

Line mode (optional)

Insert the audio cable to enter Line mode and work directly. If the headset is in wireless mode, the headset will automatically shut down and enter Line mode after inserting the audio cable.

Function Control

Power On	Press and hold the power button for 3 seconds
Power Off	Press and hold the power button for 5 seconds in any state
Volume +/-	Adjust the volume by turning the scroll wheel
Previous song	Triple-click the Power Button
Next song	Double-click the Power Button
Play/Pause	Short press the power button
Answer/Hang up	Short press the power button
Refuse to answer	Hold power button for 2 second
Clear pairing information	wireless: When turned on, press the power button five times to clear pairing information and then turn off the device 2.4G: In the power on state, press and hold the power button for 10 seconds. After restarting, the green light will flash and the Dongle will be inserted to re pair.
Dongle/Wireless Mode	Double-click the Microphone Button (Wireless - solid blue light, 2.4G - solid green light)
MIC on/off	Single-click the Microphone Button
Activate voice assistant	While the headphones are working, press and hold the Microphone Button

How to use

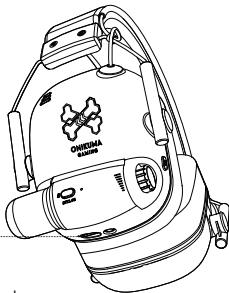
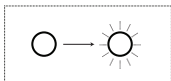

Connect using devices

1. Pressing the power button for 3 seconds while the earphones are charged will emit a "power on" sound, followed by a flashing blue light on the power indicator. At this point, the earphones enter the search pairing state.
2. At this point, please find the corresponding name of the earphone "GT887" in the device list, click on the connection, and after successful connection, the earphone will prompt a "connected" sound.
3. The earphones can remember the previously paired devices. When making a secondary connection, simply turn on the device and the earphones will enter the power on state. It will automatically reconnect with the device (if there is no reconnection, please find the product pairing name in the connection list and click to connect).
4. If you want to change paired devices while the headphones are connected, you can force the headphones into pairing mode (press the Power Button five times in a row while the headphones are powered on (connected or unconnected) to clear pairing and then power off).

The headphones enter search and pairing mode. The blue light flashes. If pairing is successful, the blue light turns on solid blue. Enter 2.4G search and pairing mode.

The green light will flash. Once paired, the green light will remain solid.



2.4G: With the device powered on, press and hold the power button for 10 seconds, then power on again. The green light will flash rapidly, then insert the dongle to pair again.
