INSTALLATION

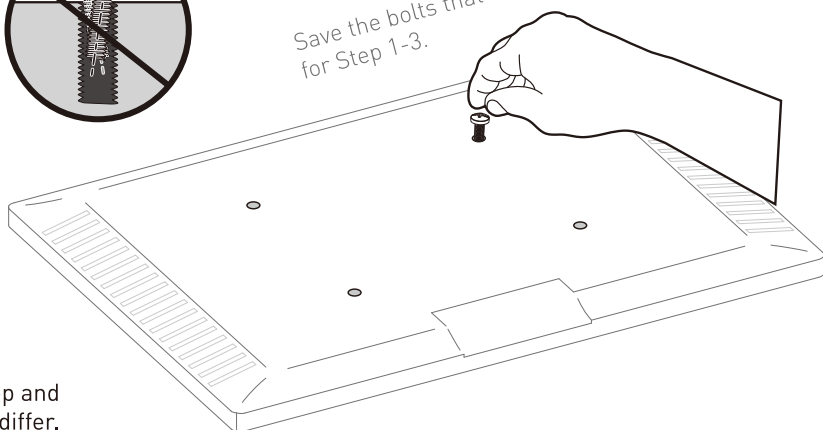
STEP 1 Attach the TV Brackets to Your TV

1-1 Select TV Bolts

The correct bolt diameter will thread smoothly into your TV.

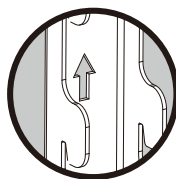
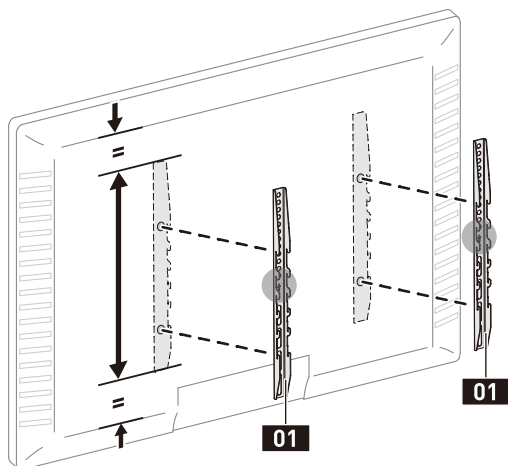


Save the bolts that fit (M4, M6, or M8) for Step 1-3.

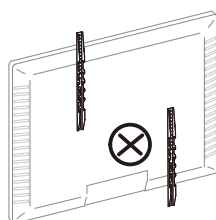
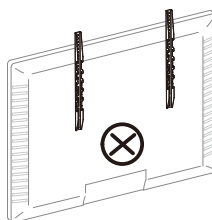
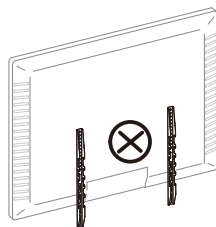


The depth of the top and bottom holes may differ.

1-2 Position the TV Brackets

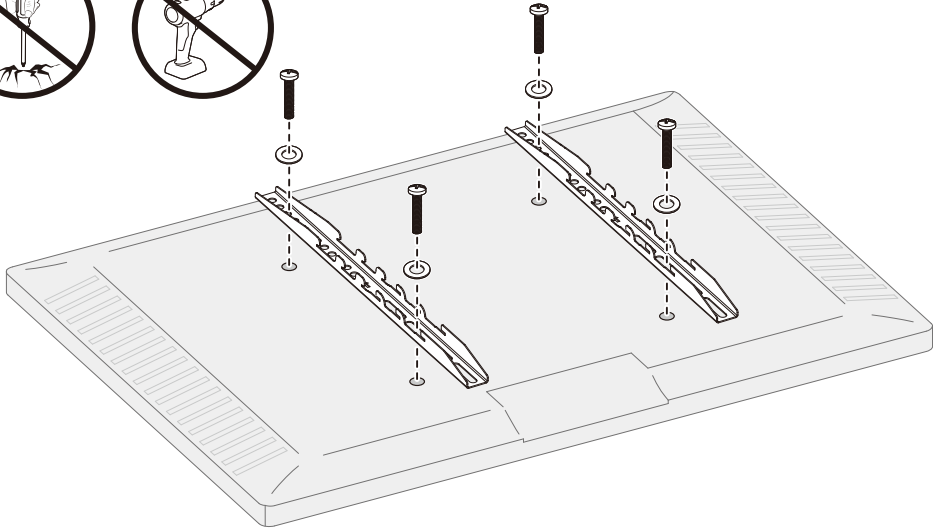
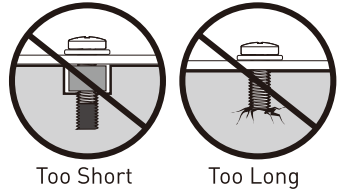


1-3 Secure the TV Brackets

For Flat-Back TV, go to **Option A** on page 08 to 09.
For Bump, Curved TV, Recessed Holes and Cables, go to **Option B** on page 10 to 11.

⚠ WARNING:

- DO NOT turn the bolt past the bottom of the hole.
- If the bolt is too short, it may not adequately support the TV.
- If the bolt is too long, it could damage the TV.
- At least 4–5 turns into the threading is required.
- **The depth of the bottom holes may be different from the top holes.**

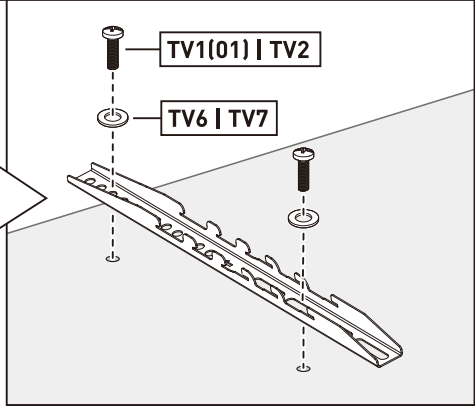


Option A

Use **short** TV bolts with washers.



Flat-Back TV

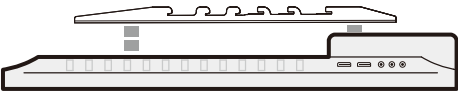

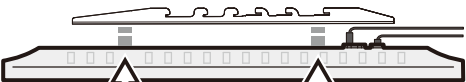
Use **long** TV bolts with washers and spacers to create extra space between the TV and brackets.



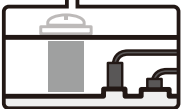

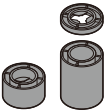


Protruding Cables

You can use a tape measure to measure the protruding bolts or hold spacers next to them to choose the right spacer combination.

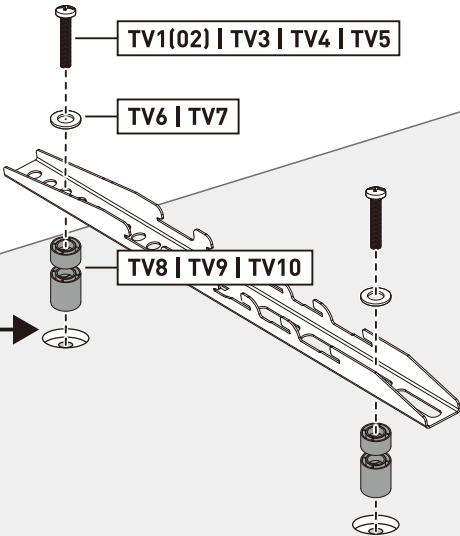

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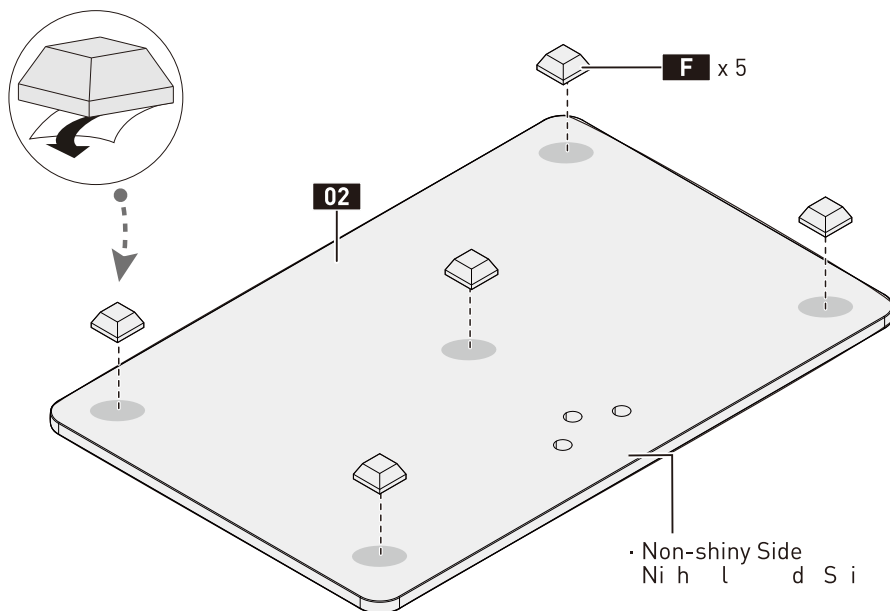


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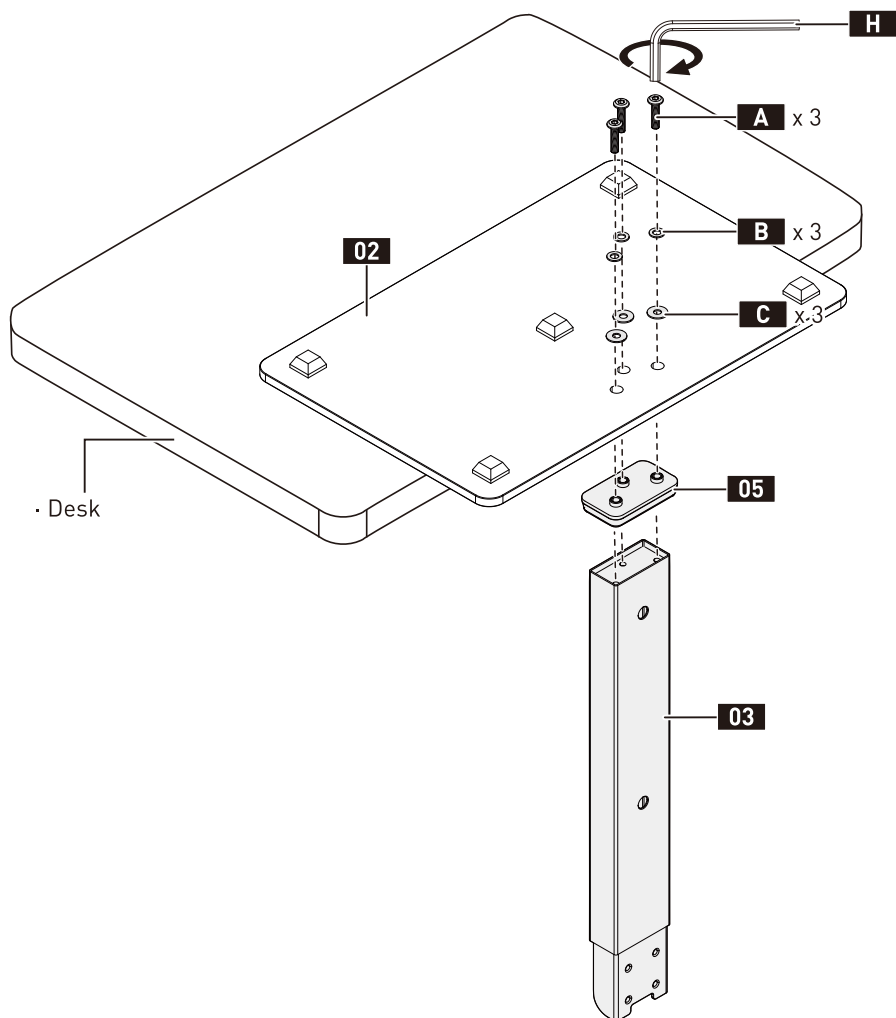


STEP 2 Connect the Support Pillar to the Base

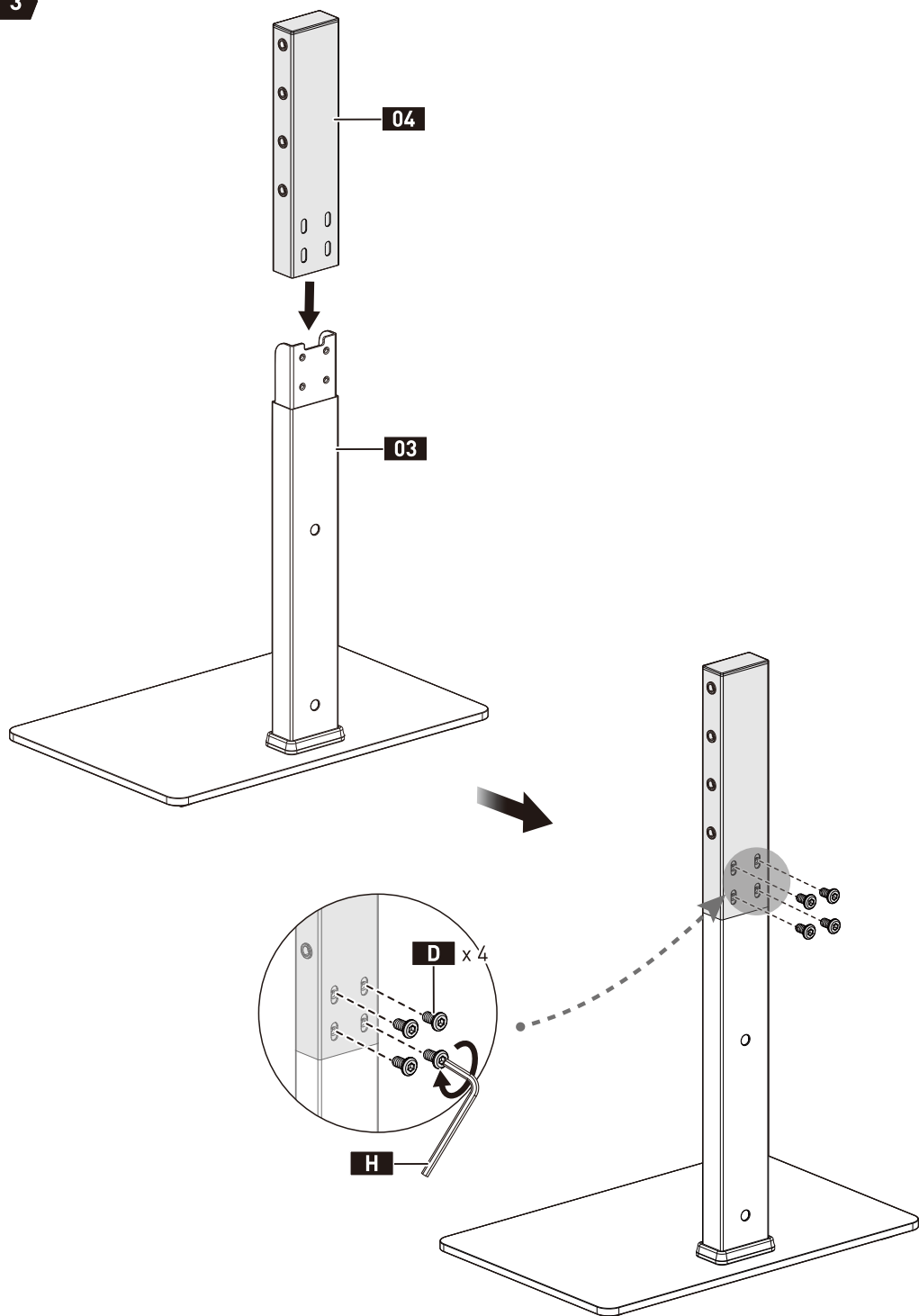


[EN] TIP: Leave a small gap between the edge of the glass and the foot pads.



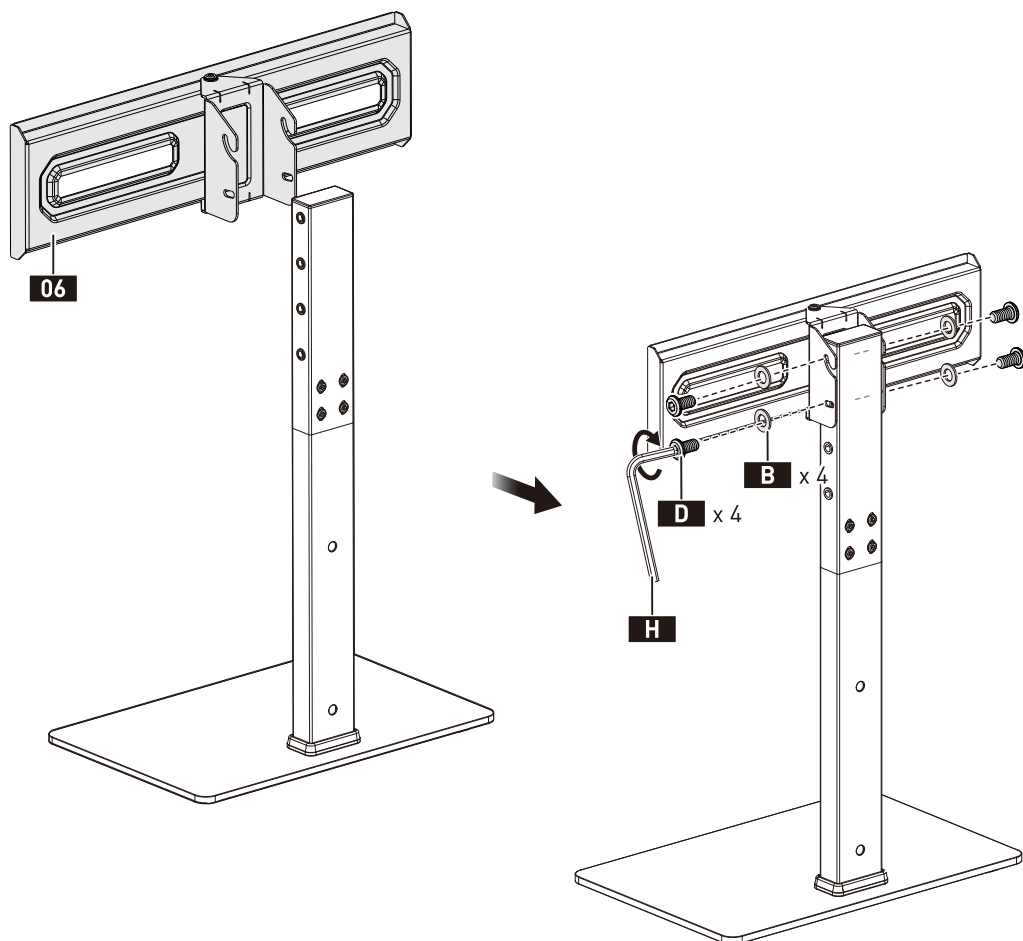
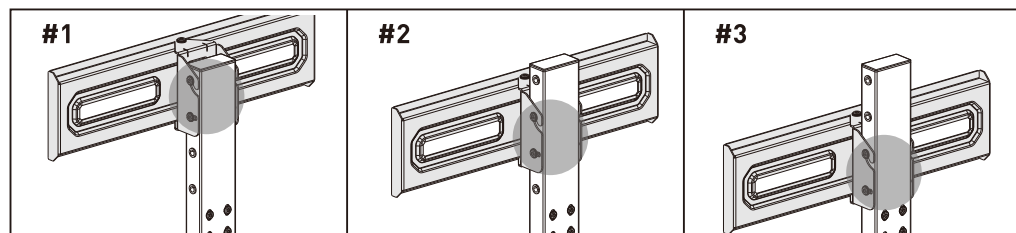
[EN] **Note:** Plastic washers **C** contact the glass.





STEP 3 Secure the TV Plate to the Extension Pillar

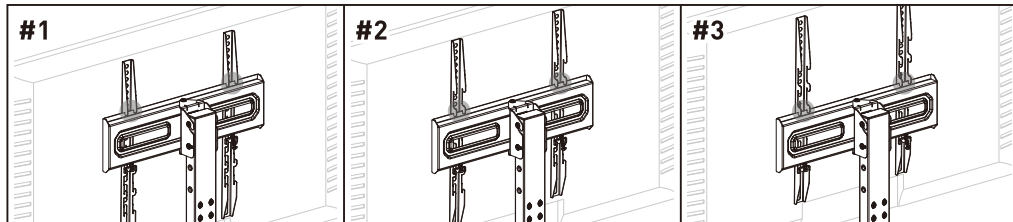

STEP 4 Hang the TV on the TV Plate

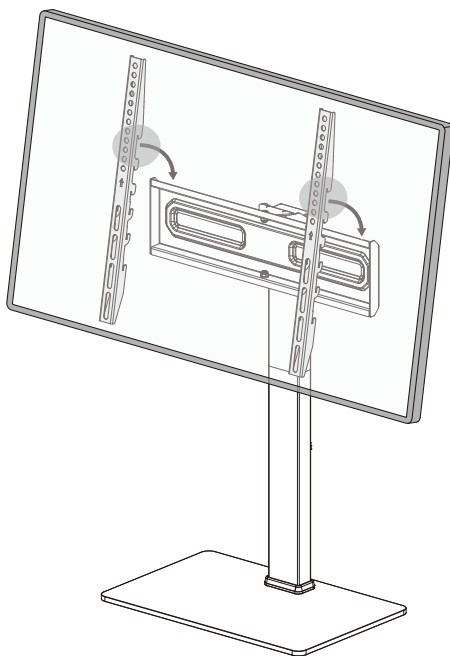

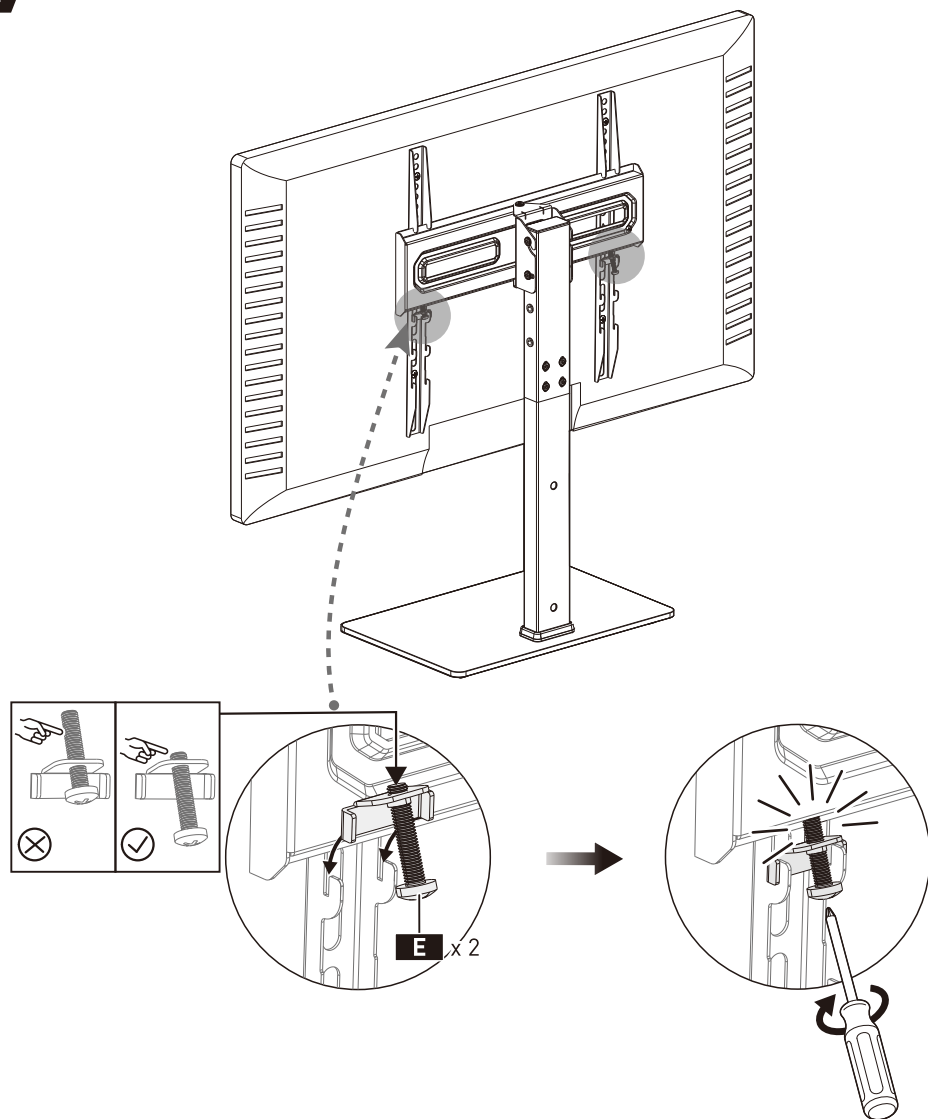

[EN] Note:

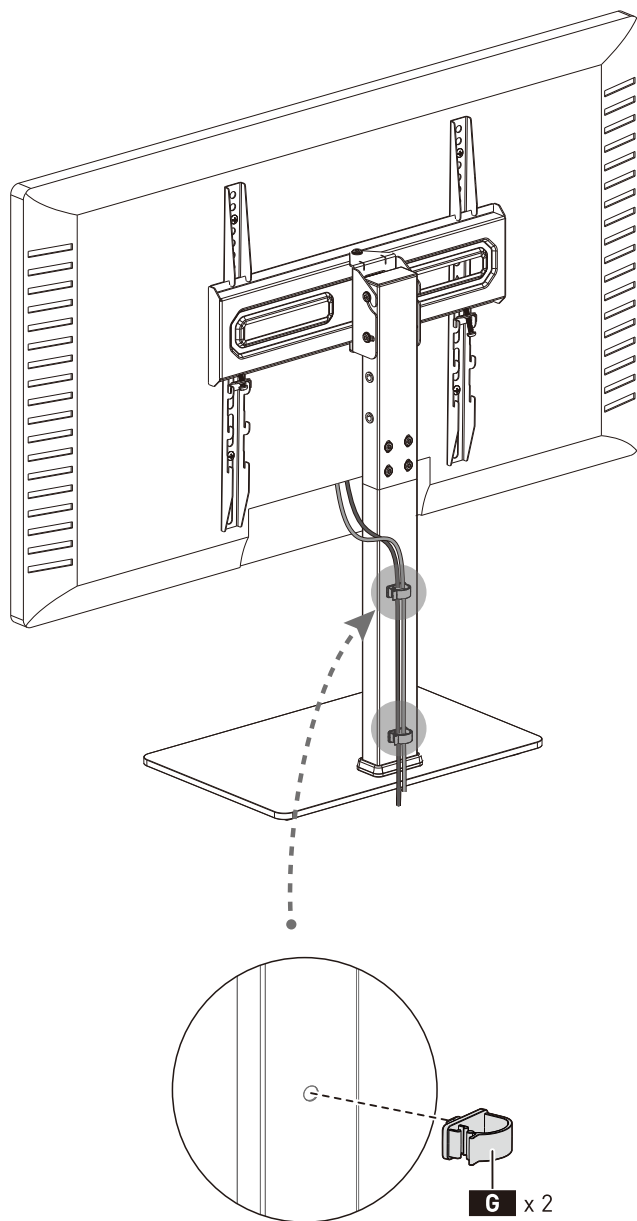
- Place the stand in the intended viewing location before hanging the TV.
- Hang the TV on the center of the TV plate.



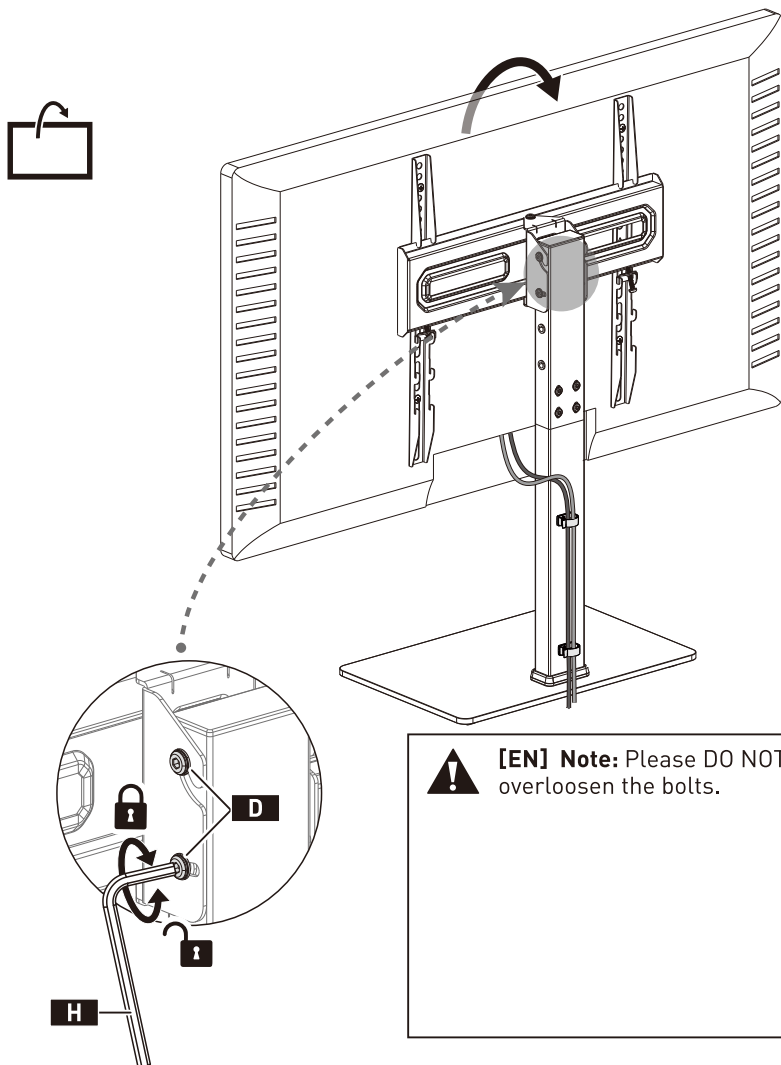


[EN] Note: Tighten the safety locks **E** until they secure against the TV plate.

STEP 5 Cable Management



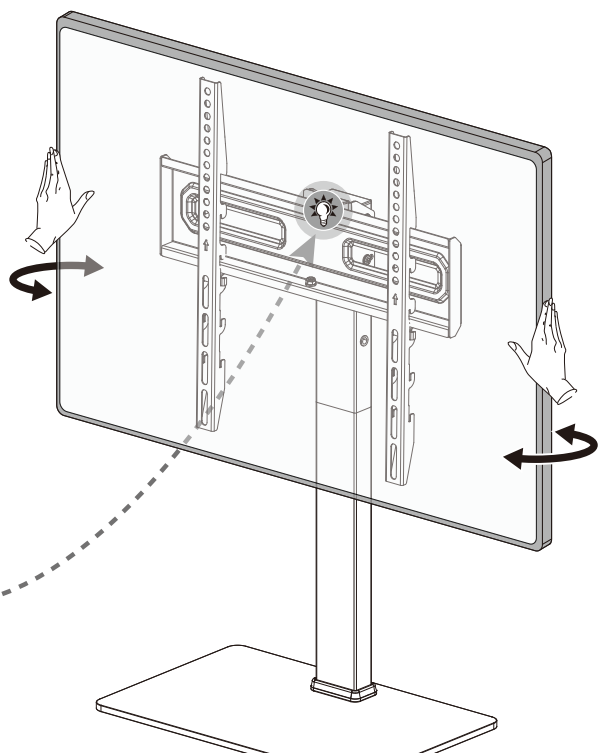
STEP 6 Tilt Adjustment



[EN] Note: Please DO NOT overtighten or overloosen the bolts.

[EN] Slightly loosen the bolts **D**. Tilt the TV to the desired angle. Retighten the bolts **D** to hold the TV in position.

STEP 7 Swivel Adjustment



[EN] Note: Please DO NOT overtighten or overloosen the bolts.

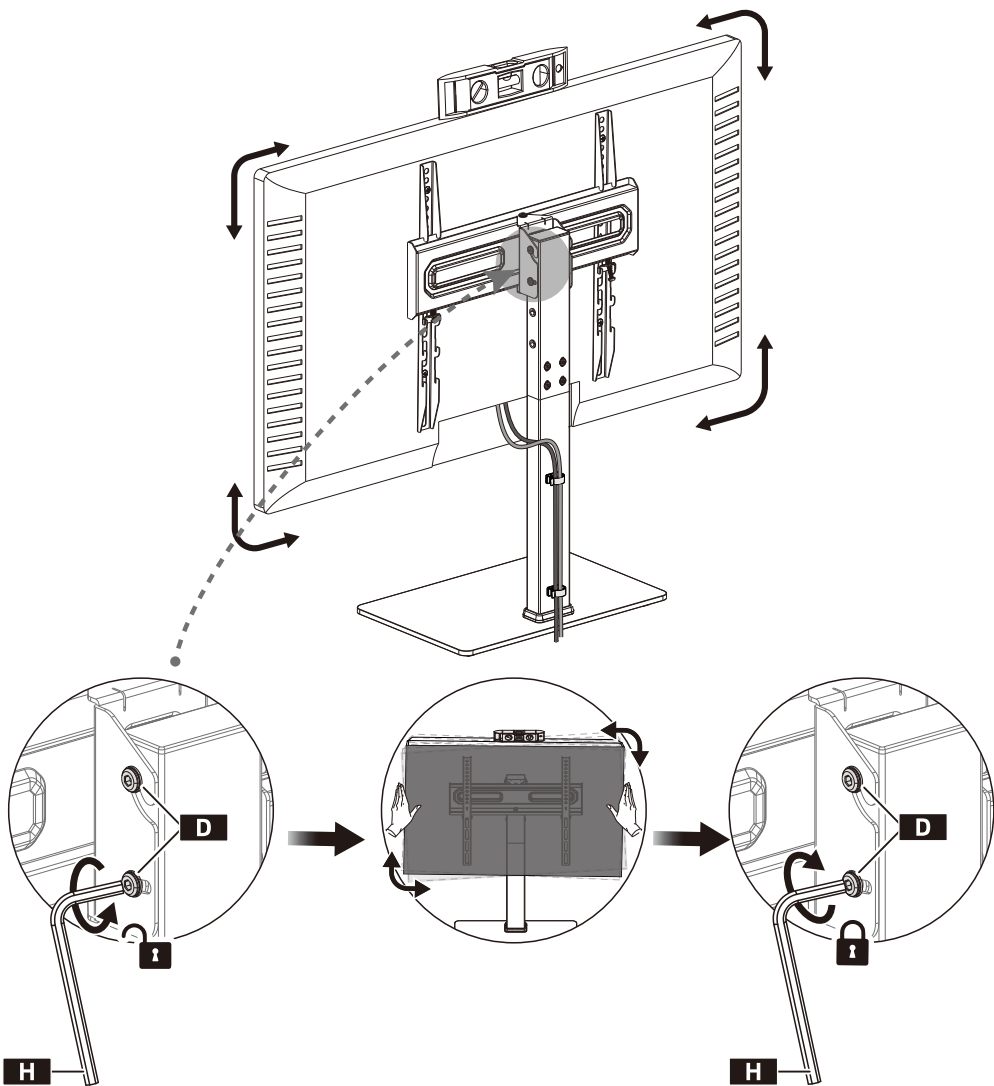


[EN] TIP: If it is difficult to swivel, remove the TV, slightly loosen the preassembled bolts, then swivel. Retighten the bolts and reattach the TV.

FREQUENTLY ASKED QUESTIONS

QUESTION ► How can I level the TV after installation?

[EN] If the TV brackets and TV are properly installed, but the TV is still not level:
Slightly loosen the bolts **D** . Level your TV. Retighten the bolts **D** to hold the TV in position.



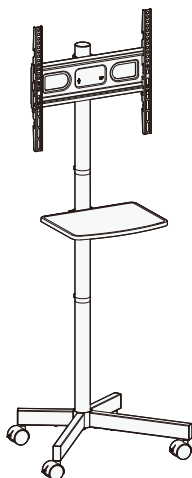
