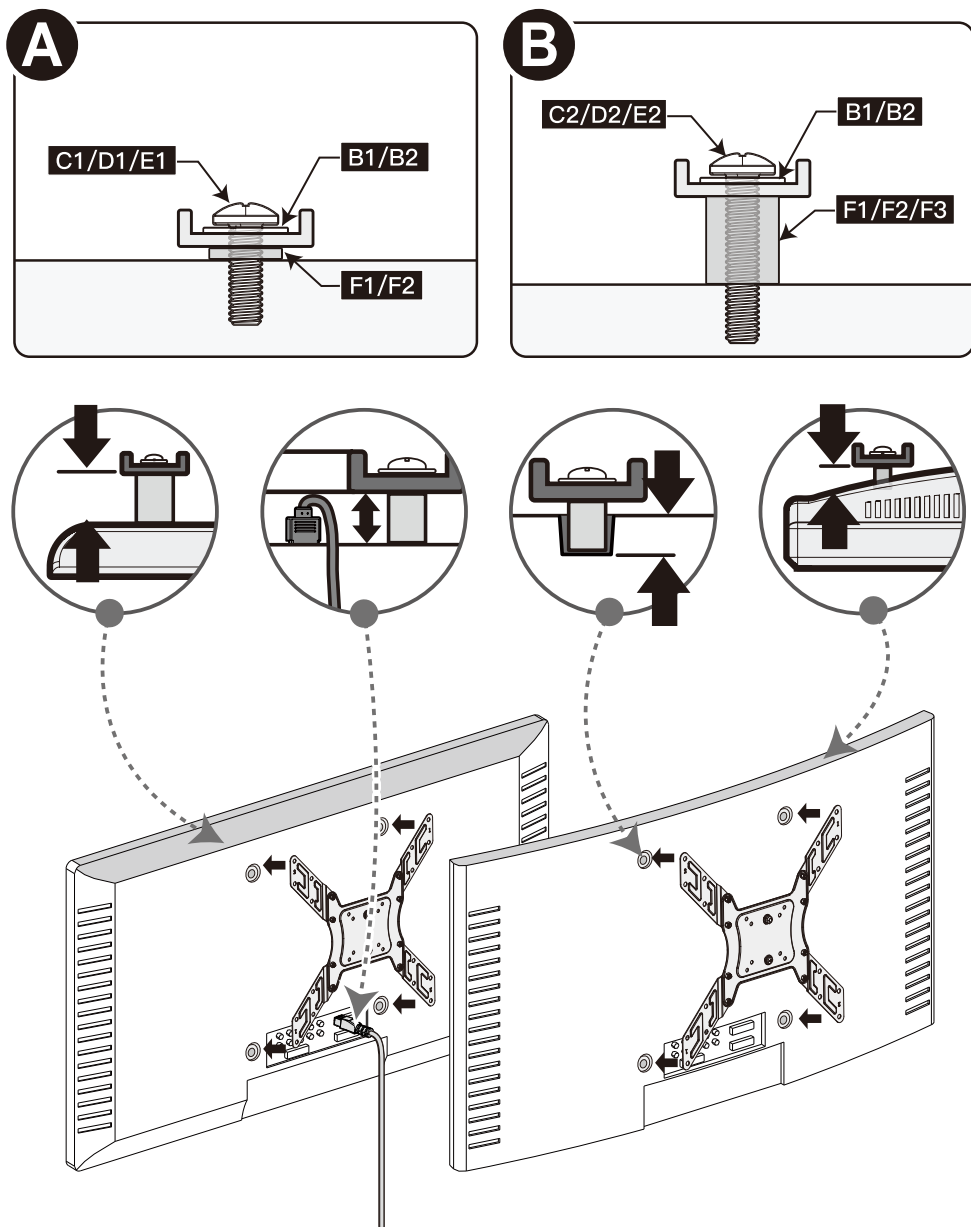
Step 2 Secure the Faceplate with Extender Brackets to the TV

2-1 Select TV Bolts

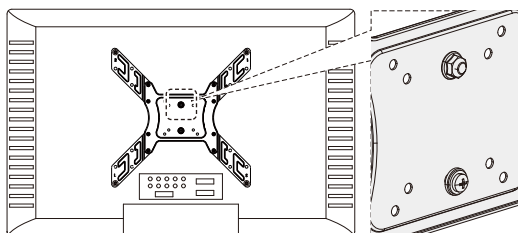


EN Hand thread bolts into the threaded inserts on the back of your TV to determine which bolt (M4, M6 or M8) to use. A minimum of 4–5 turns into the threading is required. Do not turn past the bottom of the hole.

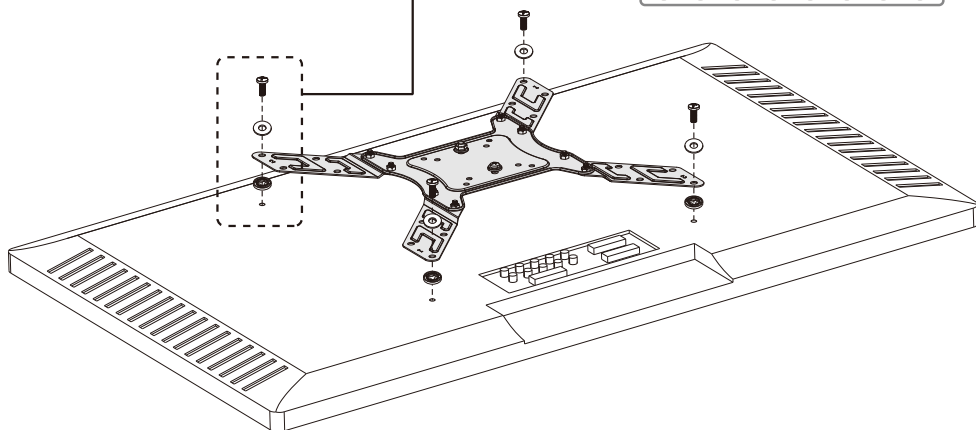
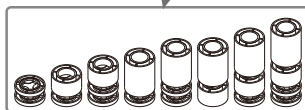
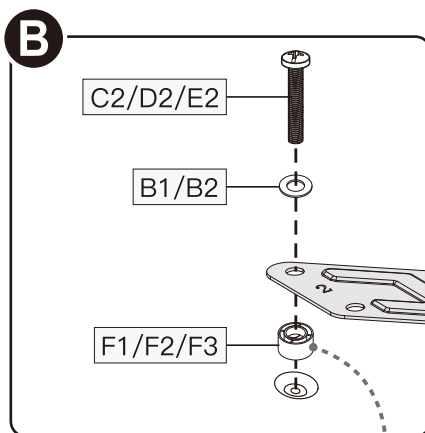
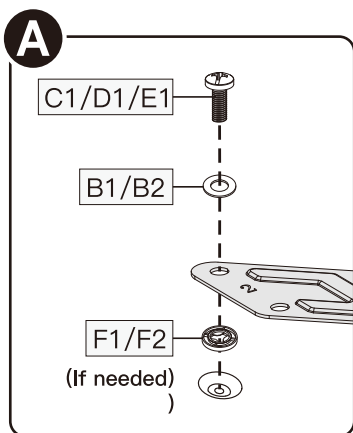

Warnings and safety information

All information regarding the use of the product can be found in the instruction manual. Before using it, read its contents and follow the instructions contained therein.

Also read the following information before use:

Warnings for use

Risk of equipment damage and falling of the device:

- Before mounting the mount, make sure that the wall, desk or other mounting surface is strong enough to support the weight of the device and the mount.
- Use only screws, dowels and other mounting hardware supplied by the manufacturer. Replacements may not provide adequate security.
- Do not mount the mount on surfaces made of low load-bearing materials (e.g., thin drywall) without appropriate reinforcements.
- Make sure that the TV, monitor or other equipment does not exceed the maximum load specified in the mount's specifications.
- Do not hang additional items such as cables, speakers or accessories on the mount, which may cause overloading.

Hazard to users:

- Always follow the manufacturer's recommendations when mounting and adjusting the mount to avoid the risk of injury. Do not undertake installation yourself if it requires specialized tools or work at height.
- After mounting the handle, regularly check that all screws and fasteners are stable and well tightened.

Hazard to children:

- Keep handles, screws and other mounting components out of reach of children to prevent accidental swallowing or injury.
- Make sure the mounted bracket and equipment are out of children's reach to avoid the risk of the unit tipping or falling.

Information on proper use

Installation recommendations:

- Before mounting, carefully read the user manual and check that the mounting kit contains all the required components.
- Make sure your TV or monitor has the appropriate mounts (e.g., VESA standard) that are compatible with your mount model.
- When mounting, use a spirit level to ensure that the mount is properly aligned and to avoid unevenness that may affect the stability of the device.
- If the mount allows you to adjust the angle of tilt or rotation, perform these operations with care to avoid damage to the mechanism or screen.
- Avoid sudden movements when repositioning the mount - they can cause the mounting components to come loose.
- For height-adjustable mounts, make sure the mechanism is locked after setting the desired position.

Maintenance and storage:

- Regularly check the condition of the handle, including the screws, hinges and mounting surface, to make sure there are no signs of wear or corrosion.
- Clean the handle with a soft, dry cloth. Avoid using aggressive chemicals that can damage the protective coating.
- For handles with spring or gas mechanisms, make sure they operate smoothly and without resistance. If necessary, contact the manufacturer's service department.
- If the handle will not be used for a long time, store it in a dry place protected from moisture and dust.
- When transporting the handle, use the original packaging or suitable protection to avoid mechanical damage.

Additional precautions

Adaptation to the user:

- Choose a mount model that is compatible with the size and weight of your TV or monitor - pay attention to the screen diagonal range and maximum load specified.
- If you plan to mount the mount on a non-standard surface, consult a professional to select the appropriate mounts.

Damage and service:

- If you detect damage, such as cracks, loose screws or difficulty in adjustment, stop using the mount immediately and contact the manufacturer's authorized service center.
- Do not attempt to repair the mount yourself - any repairs should be performed by a specialist to ensure safety.
- Replace worn mounting parts only with original parts supplied by the manufacturer.
