Function description

Input charging

1. Open the side rubber dust cover, connect the power supply or USB interface of the computer, connect the headlamp charging interface to charge it, pay attention to the power indicator to check the charging status (do not overcharge or excessively discharge).

Output charging

1. After connecting the digital device to the charging cable, open the rubber dust cover on the side of the headlamp and connect it directly to the USB interface to charge the digital product.

Using the lighting

1. Turn the key to turn on the lighting, and press the button continuously to switch the lighting mode.
2. Press the warning switch to turn the warning mode on/off. Rotate the front knob of the headlamp to adjust the far and near light.
