SAFETY PRECAUTIONS FOR USE

1. The product heats up in high light mode, which is a normal phenomenon.
2. Do not direct the flashlight beam directly at the eyes to avoid eye irritation caused by strong light.
3. Before first use or after a long period of inactivity, the battery should be charged.
4. To avoid damaging the flashlight, insert the battery into the flashlight in the correct direction.
5. During use, maintain the integrity of the battery casing. Damage to the battery casing may cause a short circuit, fire, or explosion.
6. If the battery is not used for an extended period, it should be charged and discharged every 3 months to keep it in good condition.

CHARGING INSTRUCTIONS

1. For micro USB/Type C charger Flashlight and headlamp
 - 1.1 Using a micro USB/Type C cable, connect the flashlight to the micro USB/Type C interface, and connect the other end to a charger, phone charger, or other USB device.
 - 1.2 The indicator lights up (flashes) red during charging or when the battery level is low, and changes to blue/green when fully charged.
 - 1.3 Some flashlights may serve as a power bank to charge a mobile phone or other USB devices.

2. For flashlights with batteries

Remove the battery from the flashlight and place it in the charging slot. Pay attention to the positive and negative terminals of the battery.

Note: Different products have different configurations and modes, please refer to the actual product.

FLASHLIGHT OPERATING INSTRUCTIONS

1. Press the button at the end or in the middle to turn the power on/off, tap to adjust modes,

then press the button to switch between different modes, and press and hold for 2 seconds in any mode to turn off.

2. Some flashlights have a zoom function; press and pull the head to adjust the size of the light spot.
