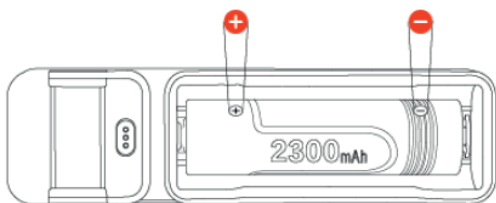

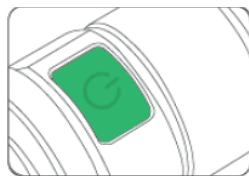
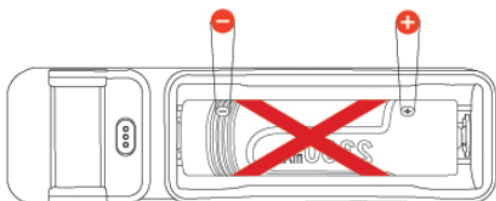
Before using the product, please read this user manual carefully.

1. Some flashlights use 18650/26650/21700 batteries as a power source. Please install the batteries in the correct direction ("+" indicates the positive terminal, and "-" indicates the negative terminal).

2. The product is equipped with a light indicator. During charging, the indicator lights up red, and after fully charged, it lights up green/blue. When the battery level is low, the indicator blinks red.

3. Do not shine directly into eyes. Strong LED light can instantly damage eyesight.

4. Use only the provided charger for charging.

5. If the battery is not used for an extended period, it should be charged and discharged every 3 months to maintain its good condition.

6. It is normal for the flashlight to warm up slightly during prolonged use.

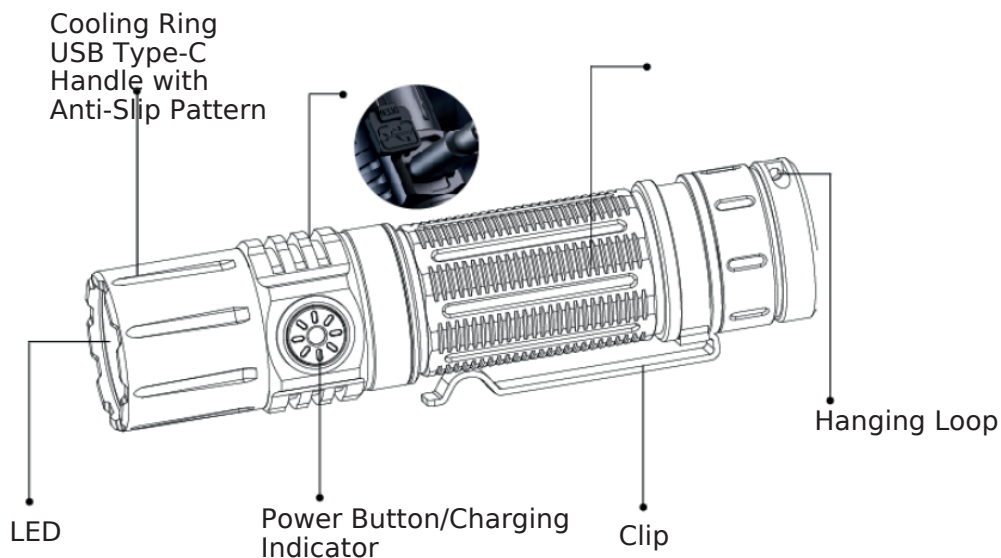
7. When the indicator shows a low charge level, the battery should be charged as soon as possible.

8. The battery should be protected from water, moisture, drops, etc.

9. To avoid damaging the surface of the flashlight, do not expose it continuously to sunlight, water, chemicals, corrosive gases, or other oxidizing agents.

10. All product parameters provided in this manual are laboratory data, serve only as a reference point, and there is no actual way to utilize them.

11. As our product series will be continuously improved, this manual may still apply to subsequent product series.



1. The A20 model has 5 operating modes. Press the button to turn on the low light mode, continue cycling through the modes (low-medium-high-strobe-SOS) to switch between the 5 modes in order, then press and hold for about 2 seconds to turn off.
2. Double-click any mode to turn on the very bright light, continue pressing to return to the position before the double-click. Press and hold any mode for about 2 seconds to turn off the light source, including the mode memory function.
3. There are multiple charging methods. The product is equipped with a Type-C charging interface, allowing the flashlight to be charged using chargers, power banks, computers, and other devices; during charging, the red indicator light is constantly on, and after fully charged, the blue indicator light is on. The mode functions cannot be used while charging.

Lower values, such as 3.2V for the cell, permanently damage it and this is not covered by warranty. If the battery or the entire device is not used for more than one month, the battery should be charged to 50% and the charge level should be checked periodically every two months. Store the battery and device in a dry place, away from sunlight and negative temperatures.
