Switching Mode:

1. Press the button when it is on; it is in strong light mode, continue pressing to adjust different lighting modes and switch between them. The HL23 series has main and auxiliary lighting modes, but the HL7S series does not have such modes.
2. In any mode, double-click to turn on the red light, press again to make the red light flash

28 times, press again to return to the original mode when the red light mode is on, and press and hold any button to turn off the light source. Sensor Function

4. Press the left sensor button to activate the sensor function; the sensor indicator will light up, and you can wave your hand to turn the light on/off. The hand-waving distance is 10 cm. Models 2HL23, HL23-A, HL23-S, HLT5-X, HL75-A, HL7S-S have the sensor function.

3. The headlamp is equipped with a Type-C charging interface, allowing charging via chargers, power banks, computers, and other devices. During charging, the red indicator lights up continuously, and after fully charged, the blue indicator lights up continuously.
