User Manual

WARNING

1. Do not shine directly into eyes, as the strong LED light may cause immediate eye damage.
2. If the battery is not used for an extended period, it should be charged and discharged every 3 months to maintain its good condition.
3. The flashlight may heat up after prolonged use, which is a normal phenomenon.
4. When the power indicator shows a low charge level, the battery should be charged as soon as possible.
5. Protect the battery from water, moisture, drops, etc.
6. To avoid damaging the surface of the flashlight, do not expose it to frequent sunlight, water, chemicals, corrosive gases, or other oxidizing agents.
7. The flashlight does not support fast charging, so a compatible charger should be used to avoid damage.

Bracket Mounting

Switch/Charging Port

1. Support for phase direction
2. Align the clamp at the back of the flashlight. Press the bracket down until you hear a click. The illustration shows the headlamp with labeled components such as the tip, bracket mounting, and switch with charging port, along with instructions for proper assembly and adjustment.
.TH03, TH04, TH04-S: Press the switch to turn on the strong light source, press again to sequentially switch modes: strong-medium-low-strobe-SOS-off. In any mode, press and hold the button for 2 seconds to turn off the light.
2. TH04-S has a gear memory function and Turbo mode. Double-click the button in any mode to switch to Turbo mode.
3. Charging indicator: the red LED lights up during charging, the blue LED lights up when

fully charged.
