RECOMMENDED SAFETY PRECAUTIONS FOR USE

1. The product may become warm in high light mode, which is normal and does not indicate a defect.
2. Do not shine the flashlight directly into eyes to avoid irritation caused by bright light.
3. Please charge the battery before first use or after prolonged inactivity.
4. Ensure that the battery is properly installed in the flashlight to avoid damage.
5. Disassembling the battery is prohibited. A damaged battery surface may cause short circuit, fire, or explosion.
6. If the battery will not be used for a long time, please discharge and recharge it every 3 months to keep the battery in good condition.

CHARGING INSTRUCTIONS

1. For flashlights and headlamps with USB charging:
 - 1.1. Using a USB cable, connect it to the USB port of the flashlight, and the other end to a USB charger, phone charger, or other USB devices.
 - 1.2. The indicator light glows red during charging or when the battery is low, and changes to a steady blue/green when fully charged.
 - 1.3. Some flashlights can be used as power banks to charge mobile phones or other USB devices.

2. For flashlights with removable batteries:

Remove the battery from the flashlight and place it in the designated charger. Please pay attention to the battery polarity.

Note: Different products may have different configurations and modes; please refer to the actual product.

4. Never expose the device to high temperatures.
5. Charge the device in a dry and well-ventilated area, away from flammable materials, maintaining a minimum distance of 1m from other objects.

6. Never use a power supply, charging station, cables, etc., without the manufacturer's recommendation and certification.

7. Take care of your property; the device is equipped with cells that are difficult to extinguish; equip yourself with a fire blanket.

FLASHLIGHT INSTRUCTIONS

1. Press the button at the end or in the middle of the device to turn the power on/off. Tap to adjust modes, then press the power button of the flashlight to switch between different modes, and a long press of 2 seconds in any mode will turn it off.

2. Some flashlights have a beam width adjustment feature - slide the head to adjust the size of the light spot. Different headlamps have different configurations and modes; please refer to the actual product.

1. Product switch and mode switch:

1.1. Press the light switch to turn on the light, then click to switch between different modes. A long press of 1-2 seconds will turn off the lamp. Some lamps do not support long pressing to turn off.

1.2. Some switches are designed for additional lights, and a long press of the switch will turn them on.

1.3. Some lamps have a smooth brightness adjustment mode. Press and hold the button to change the brightness of the lamp from high to low or from low to high, then release the button to maintain the current brightness.

1.4. Some lamps are equipped with a motion sensor switch. Press the sensor switch to turn the motion sensor on or off. Wave your hand in front of the lamp to control its brightness.

Store the battery and device in a dry place, away from sunlight and negative temperatures.
