WARNING Model Material

1. After a few minutes of use, the product will become hot, which is a normal Power Size phenomenon. Built-in battery Color White
2. Do not direct the light directly into the eyes, as the strong LED light may cause immediate eye damage. Charging input/output Waterproofness
3. Protect the product from water, moisture, drops, etc. When the Light mode 4 modes: High-Low-Strobe-Side light-Off indicator shows a low battery level, charge the battery as soon as possible.
4. If the product is not used for an extended period, it should be charged and discharged every 3 months to keep the battery in good condition.
5. To avoid damaging the product's surface, do not frequently expose the light to sunlight, water, chemicals, corrosive gases, or any other oxidizing environment.
6. Disassembly or reassembly of the products without permission is prohibited to avoid damage. Improper repairs may render the products useless.

USER MANUAL

1. Switch operation: T22 has 4 light modes: high, low, strobe, side light, off. Press the power switch to turn on the camping lamp, press again to cycle through the light modes.
2. Digital power display: the product is equipped with a digital power display with values from 00 to 100, which shows the battery status in real-time.
3. Charging indicator: During charging, the digital indicator flashes, and the number increases. After fully charging, the digital indicator remains, and the number indicates 100.
