User manual

Dear Customer, thank you for purchasing this product! Before using the product, please read this manual carefully.

1. Some lamps are powered by 18650 batteries. Please insert the batteries correctly ("+" indicates the positive terminal, and "-" indicates the negative terminal).
2. The product is equipped with a light indicator. During charging, the indicator lights up red, and after fully charging, it lights up green/blue. When the battery level is low, the indicator blinks red.

3. Do not shine directly into eyes. Strong LED light can instantly damage eyesight.
4. Use only the provided charger for charging.
5. If the battery is not used for an extended period, it should be charged and discharged every 3 months to keep it in good condition.
6. It is normal for the flashlight to become slightly warm after prolonged use.
7. When the indicator shows a low battery level, the battery should be charged as soon as possible.
8. Protect the battery from water, moisture, drops, etc.
9. To avoid damaging the reflector surface, do not expose it to constant sunlight, water, chemicals, corrosive gases, or other oxidizing agents.
10. All product parameters provided in this manual are laboratory data, serve only as a reference point, and there is no actual way to utilize them.

INSTRUCTION. Product features:

1. The flashlight has normal brightness.
2. The flashlight has only three brightness levels. Press the front button once to turn on the flashlight. The three levels cycle: high-low-off. Press and hold the button for about 2 seconds to activate the strobe mode.

3. The flashlight is equipped with large and small DC input ports, which are convenient for charging.
4. The power of the strong light is about 2.7 W and lasts for 600 minutes after fully charging the flashlight.
5. The flashlight can be used normally while charging.
