Install the viaim application on your computer

Download the viaim application on your computer, follow the prompts for installation, and then use the recording feature.

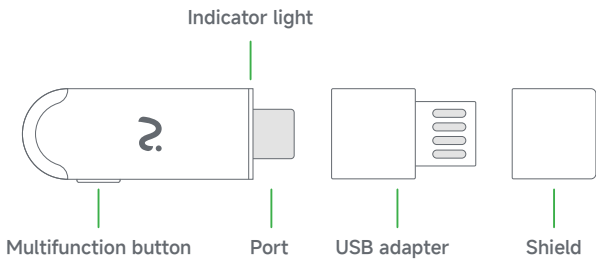

Indicator light



White light on: The device is connected to the computer but not to your viam earbuds.



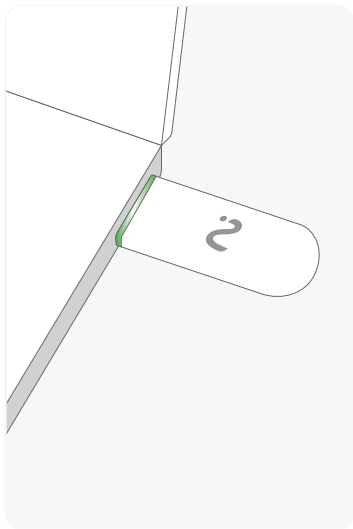
White light flashing: The device is in the pairing mode and trying to establish a connection to your viam earbuds.



Green light on: The device is connected to your viam earbuds.



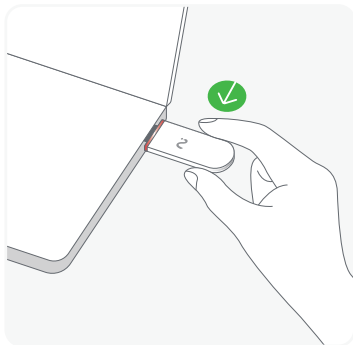
Red light on: The microphone is deactivated.



Device control

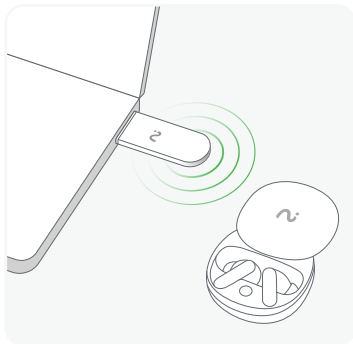
○ Press the multifunction button

Activate/deactivate the microphone.



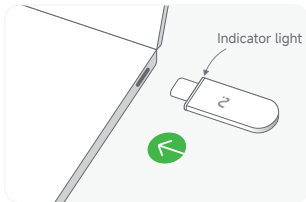
○ Long-press the multifunction button

The flashing white light indicates that the device has entered the pairing mode and is establishing a connection to your viam earbuds.

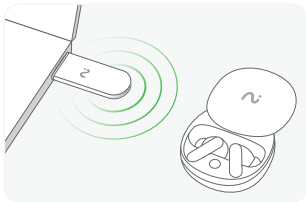


Connecting to viaim earbuds

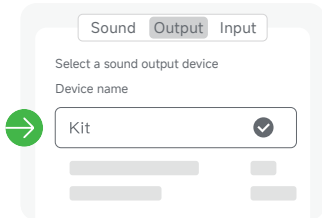
1. Connect the Kit device to a computer port and then long-press the multifunction button on the Kit until the indicator flashes in white.



2. White light flashing means the earbuds are in the pairing mode. Keep the earbuds close enough to the Kit device. Once the indicator of the Kit device lights in green, they are paired.



3. In the Sound settings of your computer system, set both input and output devices to "Kit."



Real-time recording transcription

Open the viaim application on your computer and select the desired recording mode.



- ☐ Call recording is applicable during phone calls and teleconferences.
- ☐ Live recording is applicable during face-to-face conversations.
- ☐ Audio/video recording is applicable while playing audio/video.

* Note: You can also transcribe recordings by simply connecting the Kit device to your computer without linking it to a viaim earbud. In this mode, the audio-output channel is the computer speaker, so you'll need to adjust the volume accordingly.

Hearing Safety

To avoid hearing damage, limit the time you use device at high volume and set the audio volume to a safe level. The louder the volume, the shorter the safe listening time is.
