User Manual

Switch the switch to ON or AUTO

ON: The light will remain in the ON mode.

The motion light will remain active. AUTO: Motion detection mode. The light turns on when it detects movement in a dark environment. The light automatically turns off after 15 seconds. OFF: Turn off the night light.

Dimming button: By pressing the dimming button, you can cycle through different color light modes sequentially. Solid color modes: gold, lake blue, orange-red, magical purple, grass green; Mixed color modes: ice cream, garden, sunset, party, Christmas, full moon.

Installation

Peel off the sticker from the back of the magnetic disk. Attach the magnetic disk to the location of your preference. Connect the night light to the disk.

The detection range is up to 3-5 meters in front and 1-2 meters to the sides of the sensor with a detection angle of 120 degrees. The sensitivity of the sensor depends on the ambient temperature, the type of human body, and the speed of movement.

The detection range is up to 5-7 meters in front and 2-3 meters on the sides of the sensor with a detection angle of 120 degrees. The sensitivity of the sensor depends on the ambient temperature, the type of human body, and the speed of movement. Please charge the night light before use. Cover the sensor. Use a clean, soft cloth to clean the sensor; do not use any products containing corrosive solvents. Avoid placing the night light near heat sources, such as heaters. Avoid placing the light near anything that changes humidity, such as humidifiers. Avoid direct sunlight and humid environments. Charge your night light whenever necessary.
